Events Under Science Conclave

Invited Talks: It is planned to deliver the interactive talks so that students can be motivated from the live interactions with them and follow their footsteps to make their career in basic sciences. This session will be interactive and various aspects of Science and Technology will be covered.

Science Declamation Contest: In this contest the students of various schools and colleges will be given topics related to Science and Technology. The contest will be in three groups: i) 9-12th students ii) UG students and iii) PG students. The prizes will be given to first, second and third position holders in each group.

Science Demonstrations/Display Session: This session includes the demonstrations and display of different models/projects before the students.

Souvenir: The printed material will be supplied to students in which bibliography of scientists, write-up of Invited talks, career guidance and the articles contributed by NIT, KKR students will be included.
