Guidelines for MBA Admission 2017-18

1. As the number of eligible applicants for the OBC (Regular) and OBC (Self Financed) seats are less than the number of allocated seats, the vacant OBC (Regular) are offered to the candidates from the Open Category, on Merit basis. This is in accordance with the guidelines of the Hon'ble Supreme Court.
2. The candidates who do not report for the First Counseling (Scheduled on June 27, 2016) will lose their seat in the respective category.
3. After First Counseling, the vacant seats, if any, in all categories will be notified on June 30, 2017 (As given in MBA Admission 2017-19 Prospectus).
4. **No candidate, who have either not participated in Group Discussion and Personal Interview or have not been recommended for admission by the Panel of experts, will be considered for MBA Admission in any circumstance.**
5. The candidate himself / herself must be physically present during reporting and Counselling timings.
6. The candidate is required to deposit **full semester fees** at the time of Counselling (No request for partial fees deposition will be entertained).
