**NOTICE**

The modified attendance rules as approved by Senate in its 30<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 06.06.2017 were notified by the office of Dean (Academic) on 22.08.2017.

As per the notification the students having attendance between **50% to 64.99%** were given two options as below:

1. Repeat the course through classroom/lab teaching in the respective academic session along with their junior to get normal grades.
2. To appear for end semester examination for those courses and settle for maximum of grade 'D'.

It is to be noted that the students having attendance below **50%** must compulsorily repeat the courses through classroom/lab teaching in the respective academic session along with their junior to get normal grades.

In view of above, the students who are having attendance between **50% to 64.99%** in courses and wish to avail option no. 2 above are required to submit undertaking in prescribed format in academic section/respective departments as below:

- a. Practical courses: Respective departments latest by 20.11.2018.
- b. Theory courses: Academic Section latest by 28.11.2018

As directed by the Dean (Academic), The HoDs are requested to allow the students having attendance between **50% to 64.99%** for end semester practical examinations on submission of undertaking by the students. The undertaking submitted by the students at department should be sent to the office of Dean (Academic) for further necessary action and documentation.
