NOTIFICATION

The Senate in its 35th meeting held on 31.05.2019 vide item No. S 35.05 discussed and considered the proposed guidelines/modifications by the committee for improving institute academics.

The competent authority approved following guidelines for question paper setting in End Semester Examinations.

1. The question papers should be set in a manner so that the outcomes of the course can be achieved in tangible parameters.
2. The question paper for each course should be set in such a manner that a student has no choice to leave a topic if he/she wants to score very good grades.
 - 2.1. There will be five questions in End Semester question paper.
 - 2.2. All questions will be compulsory in nature and the student must attempt all the questions in order to obtain maximum grade.
 - 2.3. There would be internal choice within a question for at least one question but not more than two questions.
 - 2.4. The questions should cover entire syllabus of the course as far as possible.
 - 2.5. Repetition of the questions with previous year question papers should be avoided.
 - 2.6. The question paper should be set in such a manner on level of difficulty that 50 % questions can be attempted by average students, 30 % questions can be attempted by good students and remaining 20 % questions can be attempted by exceptionally good students.

The HoDs/School Coordinators are requested to circulate above guidelines among faculty members for strict adherence of same from Nov/Dec, 2019 examinations onwards.
