

Please refer to above cited communication vide which a request for design as per subject cited above was sent to the undersigned.

The related documents and data has been analysed along with a site visit with the AE/JE CPWD. The proposal from your side was to provide for reuse of waste water as available from the STP in the hostels and lawns. The water supply for toilets was to be maintained for 600 inhabitants of Kalpna Chawla hostel. Side by side lawns of NIP spread over a vast area and in scattered manner were also proposed to be lirigated with surplus water from STP.

The discharge data from STP, as supplied/observed by your office, reveals that a maximum treated water discharge of 44.44 m3/hr will be available for limited hours in morning and evening. As the STP has not been working for 24 hours as on today, further limited discharge for 1-2 hours in morning and evening is available for the purpose.

On the other hand, peak demand in hostel will occur early in the morning and late in the evening. The time log and available discharge indicates that there will be no reliability of supply at the required time and for required quantity. It can be concluded that:-

- 1. With present volume of water available the need of hostel cannot be met with regularly and reliably.
- 2. To ensure reliable supply arrangement will have to be made for storage of about 54 m 3 near the hostel at one time in a day,
- 3. Separate arrangement will have to be made for sump, pump and at least 3 dedicated workers alongwith related pipe lines which will be a costly affair.

In view of above situation, it is suggested that the proposal of irrigating only lawns be taken up or considered under the present circumstances. The supply to hostels can be considered with increase in discharge at a later stage.

The work of construction of peripheral road/patrol path along the external boundary wall of the Institute for security and maintenance purpose at NIT. Kurukshetra was putup before the Building & Works Committee in its 19<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 11.09.2014 vide item no. 19.11. The same was approved in principle for an amount of Rs.2,03,60,300/- pending EIA clearance from MOEF before starting the work.

Further, in the 20<sup>th</sup> B&WC meeting held on 06.01.2015 vide item no. 20 2 (19.11) resolved that the pathway be made with ready-mix material & bitumen having width of 10ft. It was also decided that the revised cost estimate be submitted by the CPWD & the Hon'ble Director & Chairman BOG were authorized to approval the Revised Cost Estimate. In the 21st meeting held on 27.05.2016 vide item no. 21.2 (19.11) it was resolved that feasibility of providing of peripheral road of six feet width along the boundary wall of the Institute be explored by CPWD as it's a mandatory requirement from safety point of view. In reference to the decision of 21st meeting of B&WC held on 27.05.2016, a letter was sent to the Executive Engineer (Civil), CPWD vide letter no. CC/360/4920 dated 16/17.06.2016 for submission of cost estimate for the peripheral road of six feet width along with the boundary wall of the Institute. Later on the Superintending Engineer (Civil), CPWD, Chandigarh submitted a cost estimate for an amount of Rs. 2,57,11,659/- with the provision of preparation of consolidation of sub grade with power road roller, brick toe wall along patrol path sides, providing and laying 1:5:10 under the patrol path, providing and laying 60mm thick factory made interlocking paver block M-30 grade & steel work in built up sections for providing gate in hostel openings. The same was putup before the Estate Affairs Committee meeting held on 20.10.2016. The Estate Affairs Committee recommended it for further approval of Building & Works Committee.

The Building & Works Committee may consider and approve the modified preliminary-cum-detailed estimate for an amount of Rs. 2,57,11,659/- for the work of peripheral road/patrol path along the external boundary wall of the Institute for security and maintenance purpose at NiT, Kurukshetra.





The above work can be taken up by the CPWD as a Deposit work under Para 118-119 of CPWD Code, subject to the following:

- Full estimated cost of work as worked out by CPWD including departmental charges will have to be deposited by the client department before the work is taken up for execution. No interest will be paid by CPWD to the client department for such deposits.
- 2. The client department should hand over vacant possession of land/site to CPWD. CPWD may, if so required, take responsibility for demolition /disposal of existing buildings/structures.
- CPWD does not bind itself to complete the work within the estimated cost. If additional fund are required, the same will have to be provided by the client department. Necessary revised estimate will be submitted as and when required.
  - Any dispute arising out of the operation of the contract (s) for the subject work will be subject to arbitration as provided for in the contract agreement. CPWD will defend the arbitration proceedings as best as it can and get the arbitrator's award examined by the appropriate authority. The decision of the competent authority in CPWD to accept the award or to challenge the same in a Court of Law will be binding on the client department.
  - Funds for making payment of all amounts which may be decreed by a Court of Law, Tribunal or by Award of an arbitrator in relation to the deposit work will be made available by the client department promptly irrespective of it not being a party before the Court, Tribunal or arbitrator. Such payments will be addition to the payments made to the contractors for execution of work.
    - After receipt of A/A & E/S from the client department, the CPWD will prepare and submit various detailed architectural drawings and service plans to local bodies whose approvals are required before taking up the construction work. These local bodies are independent organization and CPWD has no control over them. These local bodies taken their own time for approving the Plans. The time required to get such approvals is not included in the time of construction indicated in the estimate. Although CPWD will make all efforts to get such approvals early, it may be necessary for the client department also to pursue with Local Bodies for early approval.
    - The CPWD has no funds of its own for investing in the work. The client should, therefore, ensure that adequate funds are available with CPWD for executing the work. In case the client department fails to provide funds as per requirements, it may be necessary for CPWD to suspend/abandon the work. In such eventuality, the client department shall be solely responsible for all the consequences arising out of such stoppage/abandonment of work including claims of contractors for compensation/damages.
    - The client department will help CPWD in -a) providing site for labour huts for the contractor's labour free of cost, b) providing free access to contractor's material and labour to the site of work. c) providing electricity connection for execution of work on payment of usual charges, and d) sanction and release of load from the concerned electricity boards/authority.
- CPWD may at its discretion allow the clients to deposit the funds in installments. In such case 33 1/3% would be retained for adjustment against the last portion of the estimated expenditure.


