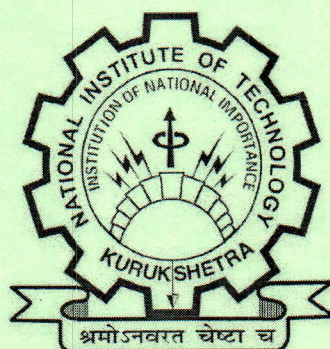

S 34.25 To consider conferment of Honorary Degree of Ph.D. (Honoris causa) on Shri Pawan Munjal, Chairman, Managing Director & CEO Hero MotoCorp Ltd.,

Mr. Pawan Munjal is one of India's foremost corporate leaders, championing growth, socioeconomic progress and technological innovations. He is the Chairman, Managing Director and CEO of Hero MotoCorp, the world's largest single two-wheeler company. He has consistently demonstrated his visionary leadership to guide Hero MotoCorp, to not just consolidate its leadership status, but also expand its global footprint across continents. Under his leadership, Hero MotoCorp achieved the coveted title of World's No. 1 two-wheeler company (in terms of volume sales by a single company in a calendar year) in 2001 and has successfully retained this position till date, for 17 consecutive years now.

It is a matter of pride for the Institute to honour him with the degree of Ph.D. (Honoris Causa) on the occasion of 16th Convocation. Therefore, it is proposed that an Honorary Degree of Ph.D. (Honoris Causa) be conferred on Shri Pawan Munjal. Mr. Pawan Munjal is one of India's foremost corporate leaders, championing growth, socio-economic progress and technological innovations. He is the Chairman, Managing Director and CEO of Hero MotoCorp, the world's largest single two-wheeler company.

Hero MotoCorp commands well over 50% share in the domestic motorcycle market in India. Since its inception in 1984, the Company has sold well over 85 million motorcycles and scooters in cumulative sales.

Hero MotoCorp currently sells its products in over 37 countries across Asia, Africa and Central and South America. The Company has seven state-of-the-art manufacturing facilities, including five in India and one each in Colombia, and Bangladesh, with a combined installed capacity of more than 9 million units per annum.
