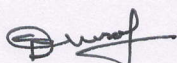

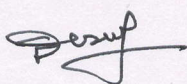

S 39.01 To confirm the minutes of 38th Senate meeting held on 06.02.2020.

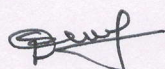

The Senate approved the minutes of 58th SCSA meeting held online on 07.05.2020. Some senators requested to grant extension to PhD students enrolled in various departments/schools. It was resolved that the period from March 23, 2020 to May 11, 2020, when the conduct of

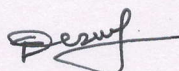


comprehensive exam, pre synopsis, seminars, submission of PhD thesis for PhD research scholars could not take place due to lock down, will be condoned for this duration only i.e. (50 days) for those PhD students whose such tasks were pending during this time interval. However, such students will not be entitled for financial benefits in the form of scholarship, if the time period extends beyond the period of scholarship available. All HoD's/School coordinators will send the list of such PhD students along with their activities pending during this period to Dean(Academic) for extending the period of completion of these tasks.

S 39.04 To consider and approve online Teaching Plan and Academic Calendar / Schedule for the odd semester of Academic Year 2020-2021 in view of COVID-19 Pandemic.

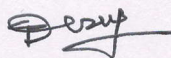
The Senate considered the agenda and approved to start the odd semester of Academic Year 2020-2021 from August 17, 2020 (Monday) in online mode for 2nd year onwards students of UG & PG and for 1st Semester students of MBA, the admissions for which have already been completed. The schedule for 1st semester students of B.Tech./M.Tech./MCA/Ph.D., will be notified later after the completion of admission process. The Academic Calendar / Schedule for the odd semester of Academic Year 2020-2021 was considered, deliberated and approved. The online teaching mode will be followed as below, till the Institute reopens and offline classes commence, as per the guidelines of Centre/State Government.

1. The time table will be prepared for regular mode (physical teaching) of the classes. However, till the institute re-opens, the classes will be held in the online mode and institute time-table will be followed for engaging the classes as far as possible. In unprecedented situations, the faculty members may choose convenient time slot for online teaching, in consultation with other faculty members and the students, depending upon the circumstances prevailing.



2. The online teaching will include Power Point Presentations (PPT's) to be shared with students. The faculty members will deliver online lectures of their courses using PPT's shared through platforms like Google Meet, Microsoft Team, Jio Meet, Skype, Webex etc. The advanced sharing of PPT's will lead to better understanding of the content by the students and help them raise queries in the online class.
3. PPT's of all experiments in each lab, with suitable illustrations and photographs of equipment/flow diagrams/line sketches etc. will be made available to the students. If possible, small videos of working of machines/carrying out of experiments may be shared with the students. The virtual lab, if available, may be used for practical classes
4. All the faculty members will provide list of links of course materials (theory and practical) of their courses, available on various platforms like NPTEL, SWAYAM, Coursera, YouTube etc. to supplement online teaching.
5. The attendance of students will be taken in any appropriate mode.
6. The students will be given assignments to be submitted online.
7. Mid semester examinations will be conducted in online mode till the Institute opens. Faculty members are to opt for Subjective/Multiple choice based Question Paper/Open book/Quiz etc.
8. The modalities of end semester examinations for the odd semester of Academic Year 2020-21 will be finalized later on, taking into account the directions of the MHRD/Central/State Governments.

Further, the senate authorized Chairman Senate to approve the Academic Calendar of odd semester for first year of B.Tech/M.Tech/MCA/PhD as and when the admission process is completed; and to make necessary changes in teaching mode





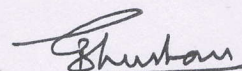

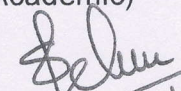

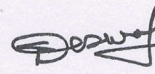
