The Finance Committee considered the case of Dr. Vikas Chaudhary, Humanities Department for performing LTC journey by the Kingfisher Airlines and decided that the matter be referred to the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Department of Higher Education, New Delhi for advice.

Item 18.6 To consider protection of pay in respect of Dr. Rishi Pal Chauhan, Asstt. Prof., Physics Department.

The Finance Committee did not agree to protect the pay of Dr. Rishi Pal Chauhan rendered in private institution before joining National Institute of Technology, Kurukshetra.

Item 18.7 To consider Extending Facilities of Free Medical Check up, prescription and clinical test/X-ray etc. to retired employees of the Institute.

The Finance Committee recommended to the Board that the facilities of free medical check up, prescription and clinical test/X-rays etc. be allowed to the ex-employees of the Institution from the Health Centre but the cost of medicines will be borne by the concerned ex-employees. However, they will continue getting fixed medical allowance of Rs. 100/-(Rupees one hundred only) per month as per earlier decision of the Finance Committee and the Board of Governors.

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## Item 18.8 To consider increase in Tuition Fees of M.Tech. Students.

The Finance Committee decided that the case be referred to the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Department of Higher Education, New Delhi for clarification.

The Finance Committee desired that the details of expenditure being incurred by the Institute from the Students Related Activity Fee/Students Fund be put up to the Board of Governors in its next meeting.

## Item 18.9 To consider Budget Provision for Outsourcing the Services of Security, Sanitation & Maintenance of the Institute.

The Finance Committee approved the Institute proposal for making a provision of Rs. 15 lakh per month in the regular budget towards services required from the Registered Service Providers as per details furnished in agenda item 18.9.

The Finance Committee may consider and approve the Annual Accounts of the Institute for the year 2009-2010 so that the same could be handed over to the Audit Party of the AG (Audit), Haryana for verification and certification.

### Item 19.4 To consider condemnation of Institute Pick-up-Van HYQ-4367.

The Institute Pick-up-Can HYQ-4367 was purchased in 1986 at a cost of Rs. 92,705.50 out of Institute Development Fund (Institute share of consultancy). It has already covered the distance of 101039 Kms. and has service duration of more than twenty years.

As per the condemnation schedule by the Govt. of India and Govt. of Haryana, the vehicle can be condemned as soon as it covers a total mileage of 1,80,000 Kms. or has completed six years of its life which is earlier.

The matter to consider condemnation of Institute Pick-up-Van HYQ 4367 and purchase of new vehicle in lieu thereof was put up in 17<sup>th</sup> Finance Committee meeting under Item No. 17.6. The Finance Committee decided as under:-

"The Finance Committee did not agree to write off the Pick-up-Van of the Institute and purchase of new vehicle in lieu of the old one due to the austerity measures issued by the Central Government."

The said Pick-up-Van has already exhausted its life span long back. As such it is not economical to maintain this vehicle any more. Copy of year-wise expenditure of the vehicle in Rs./Km. is enclosed as Annexure\_\_"C"\_\_ on page \_\_13\_\_ ). It is, therefore, proposed that the Institute Pick-up-Van No. HYQ-4367 may be allowed to be condemned and written off. At present the Institute does not require any vehicle in place of old one.

The Finance Committee may consider and make suitable recommendations to the Board of Governors.

## Item 19.5: To consider the matter of funding of Dr. R.P Singh Medal

The wife of Late Dr. R.P Singh, faculty in Mechanical Engg. requested for introduction of two silver medals in memory of her husband in the year 1995. Since then, two medals have been given to the toppers of second and third year of Mechanical Engg. Branch. Last year, vide letter dated 2.1.2009, she requested to reduce the number to one due to shortage of funds. The medal was proposed to be awarded to the topper of Final Year of Mechanical Engg. Branch. Her request was placed before the Senate in its 12<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 19.1.2009 under Item 12.8. The Senate decided as under:

"The Senate considered the request of the wife of Late Dr. R.P Singh for reducing the number of medals from two to one which was proposed to be awarded to the topper of Final Year of Mechanical Engg. Branch.

The Senate was of the view that any existing award should not be discontinued because of lack of support from the trust/donator. Dr. Baldev Setia in his capacity as President of the Alumni Association, offered to cover the shortfall of funds. In view of the above, it was decided that two Dr. R.P. Singh medals be awarded as per past practice and that as a one time measure, the Alumni Association be requested to provide additional funds for the award of medals. Further, it was decided that the committee already constituted for the purpose for considering award of medals and prizes to MBA/MCA/M.Tech., under Item 10.15 of 10<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Senate, be requested to look into the issue and give its recommendations. The minutes of the item were confirmed by the Senate."

As per decision of the Senate, the Alumni Association provided additional funds for the award of medals as a one time measure. The constituted committee submitted its report on 27.11.2009 in which it was recommended that the practice of awarding two medals be continued and any shortfall in funds may be met from the Alumni/Institute funds.

The wife of Late Dr. R.P. Singh again requested on 4.03.2010 for reducing the number of medals from two to one which was proposed to be awarded to the topper of Final year of Mechanical Engg. Branch. It may also be mentioned that the funds received are not sufficient even for the award of one medal. Her request was placed

before the Senate in its  $14^{th}$  meeting held on 14.03.2010 under Item No.14.8. The Senate decided as under:-

"The Senate considered and approved the award of medals and certificates in the 7<sup>th</sup> Convocation as detailed in the agenda item including award of Dr. R.P Singh medals as per past practice.

As regards to the award of Dr. R.P Singh medals, it was brought to the notice of the Senate that the constituted Committee recommended that the practice of awarding two medals be continued and any shortfall in funds may be met from the Alumni/Institute funds. The Institute had already expressed its inability to fund the awards. President of the Alumni Association was also requested to consider providing funds for the award of medals vide letter dated 7.12.2009. The Secretary, Alumni Association had intimated that in the meeting held on 8.3.2010, it was decided to extend the offer to meet the shortfall of funds to this year also. The Senate decided that the offer be accepted. Since the issue needs to be resolved once for all, as the same problem will crop up next year also, it was decided that the matter be brought to the SCSA where President and Secretary of the Alumni Association be invited to explore the possibility of regular funding of the award by the Alumni Association.

The minutes of the item were confirmed by the Senate as medals were to be awarded in the ensuing Convocation"

As per decision taken by the Senate in its 14<sup>th</sup> meeting, the matter of funding of Dr. R.P Singh Medal was placed before the Standing Committee on Senate Affairs in its 28<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 03.05.2010 and the decision taken is mentioned below:

"The SCSA considered the matter of funding of Dr. R.P. Singh Medal. It was decided that the matter of shortfall of funds for the award of medal be referred to the Finance Committee for consideration. The SCSA was of the view that the Institute should frame a general policy for accepting the offers to institute medals to be awarded in specific names or for specific cause etc."

All necessary documents have been enclosed as Appendix D from page  ${\bf 16}$  to  ${\bf 18}$ .

As per decision taken in the 28<sup>th</sup> SCSA meeting, the matter of shortfall of funds for the award of Dr. R.P Singh medals is placed before the Finance Committee for consideration and making suitable recommendations to the BOG.

Item: 19.6 To consider to release the arrears on account of Pay Revision of the pay scales in respect of the Ex-employees whose mapping of revised pay scales is awaited from the MHRD.

The Govt. of India, MHRD, New Delhi vide their letter No. F.10-8/2009-TS.III dated 21.10.2009 as Appendix - E from pages 20 to 23 conveyed approval of only 81 categories of Non-teaching posts of this Institute after mapping of pay scales against 94 categories mentioned in the Institute letter dated 1.12.2009 & 19.8.2009.

The Institute made a request to the MHRD, Govt. of India vide letter No. Estt-II/9337 dated 18.11.2009 to accord approval after mapping the pay scales of the above said remaining categories which is still awaited.

The Hon'ble Chairperson, BOG was requested vide letter No. Estt-II/9485 dated 28.11.2009 to accord his kind approval in anticipation of the approval of the Board to release remaining 60% of total arrears to the employees belonging to the remaining categories of posts.

The Hon'ble Chairperson, BOG has given the following remarks:-

"The payment of arrears shall be made only after the BOG approval as this relates to financial matter for which we are awaiting for MHRD's approval".

The matter was placed before the BOG in its 19th meeting vide item No. 19.23 held on 29.12.2009 and the BOG decided as under: -

"The Board decided that 60% payment of 2<sup>nd</sup> installment of arrears on account of 6th CPC be released provisionally to the non-teaching employees as per details given in the agenda item after taking an undertaking from them that aforesaid payment will be recovered from them in one lumpsum from their CPF in case approval of the MHRD is not received in a reasonable time.

The Board desired that the MHRD be requested to expedite the matter".

Accordingly, the employees who are on roll of the Institute and approval of mapping of their pay scale is not received from the MHRD have been released their remaining 60% of total arrears on account of revised pay scales w.e.f. 01.01.2006 on furnishing an undertaking from them as per above decision of the Board.

The arrears of pay revision in respect of two persons viz Sh. Ram Sarup, Carpenter who retired on 30.04,2006 and Sh. Naresh Kumar, Electrician who expired on 30.08.2008 have not been released as they are not in the services of the Institute.

Now the undertaking in respect of both the ex-employees has been given by the regular employees of the Institute. Hence, their 60% arrears of pay revision may also be

- For those who are on higher scales of pay on account of grant of ACP benefits, the corresponding Revised Pay as per Section I of Part A of the I Schedule of CCS (Revised Pay) Rules, 2008 may be allowed.
- 4. For those who have joined the institute as direct recruits on or after 1.1.2006, pay in the pay band i.e. entry pay in the revised pay structure for direct recruits appointed on or after 1.1.2006 has indicted in Section II of Part A of the First Schedule of the CCS Revised Pay Rules 2008 would apply. This will also be applied in the case of those recruited between 1.1.2006 and 29th August 2008 i.e. the date of notification of CCS (Revised Pay) Rules, 2008. In such cases, where the emoluments in the pre-revised pay scale(s) [i.e., basic pay in the pre-revised pay scale(s) plus Dearness Pay plus Dearness Allowance applicable on the date of joining] exceeds the sum of the pay fixed in the revised structure and the applicable dearness allowance thereon, the difference shall be allowed as personal pay to be absorbed in future increments in pay. Other provisions of the CCS (Revised Pay) Rules, 2008 shall also mutatis mutandis be followed.
- The approval for the extension of 6th CPC Scales of Pay to the Non-teaching employees of NIT, Kurukshetra will be further subject to the following conditions:-
- While the 6th CPC Scale of Pay would be effective from 1.1.2006, the revised rates of all allowances will be paid only w.e.f. 1.9.2008.
- ii) The revised pay scales as incorporated in Part A (Section I & II) of the First Schedule to the Central Civil Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 2008, alone may be adopted. Any proposal for Revision of Pay based on the Revised Pay Scales as indicated in Part B of the First Schedule may be examined separately.
- iii) The pattern of emoluments i.e. Pay Scales and Allowances are identical to those of the Central Government Employees, and the other conditions of service of employees of institute are similar to those in Central Government Departments;
- iv) As regards Career Progression Scheme, Institute may initiate necessary steps for obtaining the requisite approval of the Government of India before implementation of the Modified Assured Career Progression (MACP) Scheme, based on recommendation of 6th Pay Commission, for the employees of the institute.
- v) Any promotion either by way of ACP / fitment benefit, etc, given after 1.1.2006 which is not in accordance with the Government approved policy will be deemed to have been withdrawn and payment made recovered.
- vi) Up-gradation of any posts done on or after 1.1.2006 with or without retrospective effect which is not in conformity with the approved pay scale structure for such categories of employees under the Central Government would have to be reversed. Such employees may be placed in the appropriate revised pay band corresponding to their pre-revised scales of pay before such up-gradation.

- vii) Upgradation of Pay Scale of existing posts / creation of new posts should be done only with the prior approval of the Ministry. Director of the Institute should ensure that, proposals for upgradation of pay scales / creation of new posts as recommended by the Governing Body of the institute should not be implemented without the prior approval of the Ministry.
- viii) Any allowances like Overtime Allowance if at variance with Government of India will have to be brought in conformity with Government of India instructions. Any payment on account of OTA etc higher than the one admissible under Government of India Rules will have to be recovered by way of adjustment of arrears, etc.
- ix) The budgetary support for additional expenditure for implementation of the scales of pay w.e.f. 1.1.2006 will be as per the scale mentioned in Para – 4 of Ministry of Finance OM. No. 7/23/2008 – E III (A) dated 30th September 2008.
- 6. This mapping of scales of pay may be made effective from 1.1.2006, with the approval of BoG of the Institute. The revised pay in the pay band will be determined by multiplying the existing basic pay as on 1.1.2006 by a factor of 1.86 and rounding off the resultant figure to the next multiple of 10. If the minimum of the revised pay band/ pay scale is more than the amount arrived as mentioned above, the pay shall be fixed at the minimum of the revised pay band/ pay scale. Other provisions of the CCS (Revised Pay) Rules, 2008 shall also mutatis mutandis be followed.
- 7. This mapping of scale of pay would be applicable only for the present incumbents to the non-faculty posts in National Institute of Technology, Kurukshetra. New recruitments to any of the posts, in the Institute, in any manner, will be done only after approval of scales of pay for the Non-faculty cadre of NITs based on Sarangi Committee recommendations.
- 8. Now, the Institute may release the payment of second installment of arrears on account of pay revision of non-teaching employees Quasi-Government Organizations, Autonomous Organizations and Statutory Bodies etc. set up by and funded/controlled by the Central Government, according to the mapping of pay scales as approved above. This will be further subject to the conditions circulated vide this Ministry's letter No.23-30/2008-TS.III dated 14th October, 2009.

The Ministry of Human Resource Development have introduced the scheme for faculties during revision of pay according to recommendations of 6<sup>th</sup> Pay Commission known as Cumulative Professional Development Allowance for Rs. 3.00 lakhs for every block of three years (Rs. One lac per year) vide letter No. F.No.-23-1/2008-TS.II Dated 18<sup>th</sup> August 2009 issued by Director (TC). This allowance is to be made available to every member of the faculty on reimbursable basis to meet the expenses for participating in both national and international conferences, paying the membership fee of various professional bodies and contingent expenses.

The matter was placed before Board of Governors in its 19<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 29.12.2009 and decided as under:-

"The Board decided that the Cumulative Professional Development Allowance to the tune of Rs. 3.00 Lacs for every block of 3 years (Rs. One Lac per year) be made available to the faculty members on reimbursable basis to meet the expenses for participating in both national and international conferences, paying the membership fee of various professional bodies and contingent expenses be carried forward for next 6 months subject to a ceiling of Rs. 1.00 lac per year,

The Board desired that detailed guidelines be prepared in this regard and placed before the standing Committee of the Board in its next meeting".

Accordingly the Director constituted a committee under chairmanship of Dean (Faculty Welfare) and DR (GA & L), DR(A/c), Store Officer as members. The Committee drafted the guidelines and identified the contents of contingent expenditure under Cumulative Professional Development Allowance after details discussion with the faculties and study of the draft circulars of various NITs.

- 2 Papers Publishing in National/International Conferences/Journals
- 3 Participation in National/International Conferences in India/Abroad.
- 4 Visit to Indian/Foreign University for Technical Discussion
- 5 Acquiring membership of Professional Societies, both National as well as International
- 6 Purchasing of Books and Subscription of Journals
- 7 Visit to technical Exhibitions
- 8 Purchasing Computer Components, Printing Papers, Cartridge, Stationery etc.
- 9 Participating in Course Material preparation/Teaching Aids
- 10 Book Writing
- 11 Any other item with prior approval of the Authorities

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#### Guidelines:

- 1. Attending Participation in National/International Conference in India or abroad or visit to Indian/Foreign University requires approval of authorities.
- 2. Period of deputation not to exceed 2 weeks during academic sessions and no restriction during vacation as long as the period does not exceed the duration of vacation. However Director can deny the permission in case of exigencies.
- 3. it is mandatory on the part of faculty member to submit a report of activities carried out and deliver a seminar in the department before making claim for reimbursement of expenditure incurred.
- 4. Reimbursement will be made twice in a financial year as per the following schedule:
  - July (1 Oct 31st March)
  - December (1st April to 30 September) ii)
- 5. Unspent balance will be carried forward for next 6 months subject to a ceiling of Rs.1.00 Lakh per year.
- 6. No prior financial approval is required for expenditure on the activities listed above but the existing institutes rules will be applicable for reimbursement of expenditure.
- 7. Expenditure towards the purchase of books not to exceed Rs.10,000/- in a financial year. Purchase of books costing more than Rs.10,000/- shall require prior approval of the Director.
- Reimbursement for TA/DA is as per the actual bill of hotel food & local travel 8. shall be as per Institute norms.
- The first block starts from 1st October 2009 and will be ending on 31st march 9. 2012 and hence the amount available to a faculty member for this block is proportionately Rs.3.00 Lacks: Next block will be of complete 3 years.
- Expenditure on the activities listed above is auditable and faculty member will 10. be responsible for clarifying audit objection if any.

## Item 19.8

To consider expenditure under Cumulative professional Development Allowance (CPDA) meant for faculty.

The Ministry of Human Resource Development have introduced a scheme for faculty members during revision of pay scales according to VI th Pay Commission known as Cumulative Faculty Development Allowance (CPDA) for Rs 3 lakhs for every block of three years (Rs. One lac per year) vide letter no.F.No.-23/2008-TS.II Dated 18<sup>th</sup> August 2009 issued by Director (TC). This allowance is to be made available to every member of the faculty on reimbursable basis to meet the expenses for participating in both national and international conferences, paying the membership fee of various professional bodies and contingent expenses.

The matter was placed for approval before Board of Governors in its 17<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 09.09.2009 and decided as under:-

"The Board allows the Cumulative Professional Development Allowance to the faculty for participating in National and International Conferences as per details furnished in the agenda item"

The matter was again placed before the Board of Governors in its 19<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 29.12.2009 and the Board decided as under:-

"The Board decided that the Cumulative Professional Development Allowance to the tune of Rs. 3.00 Lacs for every block of 3 years (Rs. One Lac per year) be made available to the faculty members on reimbursable basis to meet the expenses for participating in both national and international conferences, paying the membership fee of various professional bodies and contingent expenses be carried forward for next 6 months subject to a ceiling of Rs. 1.00 lac per year,

The Board desired that detailed guidelines be prepared in this regard and placed before the standing Committee of the Board in its next meeting".

The Director constituted a committee under chairmanship of Dean (Faculty Welfare) and DR (GA & L), DR(A/c), Store Officer as members to prepare guidelines for spending the CPDA. The Committee after consulting practice being followed in MNIT, Bhopal and SVNIT, Surat recommended that reimbursement for utilizing the CPDA will be made twice in a financial year. But the Teachers Association is pressing hard that payments of the expenditure against the CPDA should be made regularly against the submission of bills instead of two times in year.

Regarding decision taken by the BOG in its 19<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 29.12.2009, the Teachers Association has resolved that the CPDA should be truly cumulative for three years as per the provision in the Pay scale. In this connection it is proposed that the CPDA may be made available to the faculty for the block year 2009-2012 as under:-

1.10.2009 to 31.3.2010 Rs.50000/-

1.4.2010 to 31.3.2011 Rs.100000/-

1.4.2011 to 31.3.2012 Rs.100000/-

Total Rs.250000/-

The available amount is to be utilized within the said block and not be carried forward beyond 31<sup>st</sup> March 2012. The next block of 3 years would be from 01.4.2012 to 31.3.2015 and then so on.

The Finance Committee may consider and make suitable recommendations to the Board.

Item 19.9 To consider the budget provision for the development plan of Centre of Continuing Education and External Collaboration (CCEEC) at NIT, Kurukshetra.

The Board of Governors in its  $19^{\text{th}}$  meeting held on 29.12.2009 decided as under:

"Dr. Pankaj Chandna, Professor Incharge, CCEEC gave a presentation of organizational structure, infrastructural requirements, manpower requirements, activities to be undertaken and financial aspects in the form of PPT before the Board. During the presentation Dr. Chandna requested for an amount of Rs.10.00 lacs as seed money to start the function of the above Cell. Dr. Chandna assured the Board that the Cell will start its formal functioning within three months i.e. from 1st April, 2010.

The Board decided to sanction 50% of the required seed money i.e. Rs.5.00 lacs initially in the last quarter of current financial year 2009-2010 and the remaining 50% will be granted during next financial year on the basis of performance of the Cell."

In view of the above decision of the Board, the Centre of Continuing Education and External Collaboration (CCEEC) has been set up in the Institute w.e.f. 1.4.2010. The Institute made a provision of Rs.2.00 lacs for the said purpose in the RBE (Non-plan) for the year 2009-2010 but the budget provision made lapsed due to its non-utilization. A sum of Rs.2.00 lacs has also been provided in the OBE for 2010-11 which has since been transferred to the Centre for the infrastructural requirements and other activities.

It is proposed that the additional budget provision for the remaining Rs.08 lacs (out of the total sanctioned seed money of Rs.10.00 lacs, as already approved by the Board) may be incorporated in the revised budget estimates for 2010-2011 under Non-Plan Grant for further development activities in CCEEC.

The Finance Committee may consider and decide.
