GUIDELINES FOR ONLINE EXAMINATIONS (FOR ODD SEMESSRER OF AY 2020-2021)

- 1. The students are required to join for the online examination on the link sent by the course-coordinator/examiner.
- 2. The course coordinators/examiners will act as invigilator for the examination.
- 3. The mobile number and e-mail of the faculty conducting the examination must be mentioned on the question paper. In case of any difficulty /issue during the online examination, the students may contact the faculty at that number. The decision of the course-coordinator/examiner will be final.
- 4. The question paper will be sent by the course-coordinator/examiner 10 minutes before the commencement of examination via e-mail/google classroom/WhatsApp.
- 5. All the students are required to switch the camera of laptop/mobile in ON position during the examination.
- 6. The students will be given 2 hours for answering the question paper. The students will be given 20 minutes (from the end of examination time) to submit the PDF file of the all answer sheets by e-mail (as mentioned on question paper) to the course coordinators/examiners. The total exam duration will be 2 hours and 30 minutes as below:

- 7. The question paper may have multiple choice/subjective/blended questions.
- 8. The students will use A4 size papers as answer sheets. They will write the course name and code along with their Roll No, signatures and total number of pages used on the first page.
- 9. The students are also required to write their Roll No and signatures on each page of the answer sheet.
- 10. The samples of first and subsequent pages of answer sheets are attached as Annexures A & B respectively.
- 11. The maximum page limit for answering question paper is 30 pages including graphs.
- 12. It is mandatory to specify page number on each answer sheet. As an illustration for a student using 18 pages as answer sheets, page numbering will be as 1/18, 2/18, 18/18.
- 13. The students must use blue/black pen only for writing their answers.
- 14. The students shall not mention their mobile number and name on the answer sheat.
- 15. At the end of schedule time, the students will make a PDF file of answer sheet naming it as Roll No.pdf (As an illustration 1181xxxx.pdf) and submit it on the e-mail id of the coordinator/examiner mentioned on question paper.
- 16. The evaluation record of the answer sheets of the course will be saved in excel format and the same will be shared with the students by e-mail after evaluation of answer sheets, before the final submission of awards to the examination branch as per the procedure.

- (i) The applicants should be professionally employed as engineers or scientists in Public Sector Undertakings or Government Departments or national level R&D organisation/national laboratories/industry, having sufficient facilities to carry out research at their place.
- (ii) Regular faculty of reputed Institute/University/College having sufficient facilities to carry out research at their place in the related research area.

All such candidates should have a minimum experience of two years at the level of Assistant Professor or equivalent as regular employee in the sponsoring institute/university/college/organisation or R&D organization/national laboratory/industry at the time of applying for admission. Minimum qualification for these candidates is the same as for full-time candidates

Regular employees of the Institute do not fulfill the above conditions.

In order to promote higher education for employees of the Institute, it is proposed to waive off these additional eligibility conditions for pursuing Part-time Ph.D at our Institute. However, they have to fulfill the minimum educational qualification as per R 3.1 of the Ph.D. ordinance and should have a minimum experience of two years as regular employees in the Institute.

The Senate may consider and decide.

ELIGIBILITY

R-3.1 Educational Qualifications

An applicant possessing the prescribed qualifications shall be eligible for admission to a Ph.D. program of the institute. Degrees obtained through distance education programs shall not be considered. The course as well as University of qualifying degree must be recognized by AICTE-UGC and will be verified by Academic Section before registration.

In order to encourage the candidates for interdisciplinary research which is the state of art in today's scenario, the eligibility criteria for Ph.D. is as below:

Master's degree in respective discipline or equivalent with a minimum Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of 6.5 on a 10-point scale or equivalent as determined by the Institute wherever letter grades are awarded, or 60% marks in aggregate where marks are awarded.

OR

Bachelor's degree in Engineering/Technology with a minimum of 70% marks in aggregate or equivalent CGPA and a minimum of 10 years of work experience (at the level of Assistant Professor or equivalent) in an engineering degree level technical Institute or R&D organization industry and Evidence of Master's level R&D work completed

R-3.2 Additional Eligibility Conditions for Part-Time Ph.D. Admission

- (i) The applicants should be professionally employed as engineers or scientists in Public Sector I indertakings or Government Departments or national level R&D organisation/national laboratories/industry, having sufficient facilities to carry out research at their place.
- Regular faculty of reputed Institute University College having sufficient facilities to carry out research at their place in the related research area.

All such candidates should have a minimum experience of two years at the level of Assistant Professor or equivalent as regular employee in the sponsoring institute/university college/organisation or R & D organization national laboratory industry at the time of applying for admission

Minimum qualification for these candidates is the same as for full-time candidates.

Part-time candidates are required to submit a "No Objection Certificate" on a proper letterhead from the appropriate authority in the organization clearly stating the following.

- The candidate is permitted to pursue studies on a part-time basis
- That his/her official duties permit him/her to devote sufficient time for research
- Facilities for research in the candidate's field of research are available at the candidate's place of work

S 42.08 To introduce part-time M.Tech. programme in the Institute under self-financing scheme

The Institute is offering full-time Postgraduate programmes in various disciplines of Engineering & Technology, Sciences, Management and Computer Applications. Engineering graduates working in degree level Institutes, Public & Private sector and R&D organizations and desirous of enhancing their qualification, find it difficult to pursue full-time PG programmes. Institutions of national Importance have social obligations towards upgrading the technical capabilities of the manpower in their region. It is, therefore, proposed to start part-time M Tech. programme in some disciplines under self-financing scheme. This will also help the Institute to enhance its outreach activities, internal resource generation and perception. The Senate may deliberate upon the proposal.

In case, the Senate agrees upon the agenda, a Committee may be constituted to finalize the modalities like essential qualifications, admission criterion, number of seats, duration of program, fee structure etc.

S 42.09 To decide the modalities of end semester examinations of UG/PG/Ph.D. for even semester of AY 2020-21.

The Senate in its 40th meeting held on 17 11.2020 vide item no. S 40.09 & S 40.10 considered and approved the online teaching mode for the even semester of AY 2020-21 in view of COVID-19 pandemic. Further, it was decided that the modalities of end semester examinations for the even semester of AY 202021 will be finalized later on, taking into account the directions of MoE/Central/State Govt.

The Senate may decide the modalities of end semester examinations of UG/PG/Ph.D for even semester of AY 2020-21.

S 42.10 To decide the modalities for conduct of M.Tech. viva-voce for even semester of AY 2020-21.

In last Academic Year 2019-20, M Tech. students submitted their thesis/dissertation (as pdf document) online to the concerned supervisor with a copy to HoD/School Coordinator, examination branch/library. The HoD/School Coordinator appointed an internal faculty member (as subject expert) who in coordination with thesis/dissertation supervisor conducted the viva-voce examination online. No external examiner was appointed for the conduct of viva-voce.

As the students could not present their papers in conferences due to prevailing conditions of COVID-19, the condition/need of publications for securing particular grade was waived off. However, the students who published/presented papers in Journals/conferences were given due weightage/consideration accordingly while awarding marks/grade.

The Senate may decide the modalities for conduct of M.Tech. viva-voce for even semester of AY 2020-21.
