The SCSA in its 52nd meeting held on 13.9.2017 decided that for the release of M.Tech GATE scholarship, CGPA/SGPA for various categories is to be adopted as per the guidelines issued by CCMT, time to time. However, other conditions are to be maintained as per MHRD norms.

In view of above, as per CCMT guidelines, the following criteria is applicable to existing candidates for the grant of M.Tech GATE scholarship:-

Minutes of SCSA meeting (52.1) held on 13-9-2017

Item 52.1: To modify norms for continuation of GATE scholarship to M.Tech. students based on CGPA on the basis of requests received from M.Tech. students.

Keeping in view the norms and guidelines issued time to time, various issues as raised by Dean (Academic) related to M.Tech GATE scholarship were discussed & decided as:

- i) For the award and continuation of M.Tech GATE scholarship, CGPA/SGPA for various categories is to be adopted as per the guidelines issued by CCMT, time to time. However, other conditions are to be maintained as per MHRD norms.
- ii) Issues related to re-continuation of Scholarship after a break was discussed and keeping in view the discussions held in the meeting, matter is to be taken up in the forthcoming Senate meeting as an agenda item.

Item 52.1 To modify norms for continuation of GATE scholarship to M.Tech students based on CGPA on the basis of requests received from M.Tech students

Some M.Tech students of the Institute have requested to grant/continue scholarship on the basis of SGPA/CGPA as per CCMT guidelines whereas the GATE scholarship to the M. Tech students of the Institute is being granted as per rules, terms and conditions of the Govt. of India, MHRD, New Delhi issued from time to time. The relevant Clause (d) regarding continuation of GATE Scholarship as per MHRD letter No. F.18-42/96.TS.III dated 17.9.98 is as under:-

*"The student must secure a first class or equivalent, CGPA/Grade during the first semester and the second semester examinations to become eligible for continuance of scholarship at the enhanced rate during the second semester and the third semester respectively. Scholarship once discontinued will not be continued again, even if a student secures first class or equivalent CGPA/Grade after second semester".

Thereafter the scholarship amount has been enhanced from time to time by the MHRD, but the rules for continuation of scholarship have not been changed.

According to CCMT-2016 guidelines, the minimum eligibility condition for M.Tech admission in terms of CGPA/CGPI or % marks and stipend is as under:-

Minimum eligibility is 6.0 CGPA/CGPI on 10 point scale or 55% marks for SC/ST/PWD candidates and 6.5 CGPA/CGPI on 10 scale or 60% marks for OC/OBC candidates.

As per MHRD guidelines the admitted candidates through CCMT-2016 will be getting a stipend of Rs. 12,400/- month (which is changeable time to time as per MHRD directions) in condition they have to maintain their CGPA 6 and above (for SC & ST) and 6.5 and above for rest of the categories" (Copy attached).

Similarly in CCMT-2017 guidelines also, the category-wise minimum eligibility criteria in terms of CGPA/CGPI or % marks and stipend is as under:-

Further as per MHRD guidelines the admitted candidates through CCMT-2017 will be getting a stipend of Rs. 12,400/- month (which is changeable time to time as per MHRD directions) in condition they have to maintain their CGPA 6 and above (for SC&ST) and 6.5 and above for rest of the categories CCMT-2017 (Copy attached).
