At the outset, Director & Chairman, Senate welcomed the members of the Senate and accorded permission to present the agenda of the meeting for consideration of the Senate.

The agenda was taken up and following decisions were taken in the meeting:

S 30.01 To confirm the minutes of the 29th meeting of the Senate held on 20.2.2017.

S 30.02 To note the actions taken on the minutes of the 29th meeting of the Senate held on 20.02.2017.

The Senate noted the action taken on the minutes of the 29th meeting of the Senate held on 20.2.2017.

S 30.03 To consider the revised Academic Curriculum for the Bachelor of Technology (B.Tech.) program of the Institute.

Revised Academic Curriculum for the Bachelor of Technology (B.Tech.) program of the Institute was placed before the Senate for its consideration. It was informed that the curriculum had been arrived at after a series of meetings at various levels, referring to model curriculum suggested by different departments, the curriculum in force in some of the premiere institutes of the country and after getting valuable inputs from eminent academicians.





Thereafter, presentations were made by Dean (Academic) and Heads of Departments of Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Humanities and Social Sciences, Civil Engg., Electrical Engg., Computer Engg. & IT, Electronics & Comm. Engg., Mechanical Engg. and Production and Industrial Engg. Presentations were duly interspersed with discussions.

It was resolved to adopt the new revised curriculum for the Bachelor of Technology Programme of the Institute w.e.f. 2017-18 batch onwards. Further, the Director was authorized to consider the suggestions etc. of the members in consultation with Dean (Acad.) and others, if required.

Further, grading system needs to be introduced and an agenda may be put up for deliberations in next Senate.

S 30.04 To consider the attendance requirement as eligibility for appearing in the End-semester examinations.

The issue was deliberated upon in detail. The Senate approved the proposal of criteria of minimum requirement of attendance for being eligible to appear in the end semester examinations as proposed in the agenda.

S 30.05 To consider change in awards after re-evaluation.

The Senate discussed the issue w.r.t. two aspects:

- 30.05.1 Possible shortcomings in the existing rule of re-evaluation.
- 30.05.2 Continuance/Discontinuance of the procedure of re-evaluation.

For 30.05.1, it was decided that if the re-evaluated marks change the status of a student in that paper from "Fail to Pass", it will be considered, even though the change in marks may be less than 15%. This shall also apply to the existing candidates whose cases are under consideration presently.



For 30.05.2, it was decided to discontinue the practice of re-evaluation in future. However, the following practice of appeal in force shall continue.

A student not satisfied with his marks may approach the faculty. If satisfied, ok.

If not satisfied, he/she can approach the coordinator of that course. If satisfied, ok.

If not satisfied, the student may approach the Head of the Department and request the Head of the Department in writing. Head of the Department may constitute a committee of 2-3 faculty. The decision of the committee will be final and binding.

S 30.06 To consider Unfair Means Rules for students of all programmes.

The Senate appreciated the concern for having a set of rules for punishment to students resorting to use of unfair means. It was decided to constitute a committee with Prof. V.K. Bajpai as Head of the Committee. The Committee will submit its report within one month.

S 30.07 To consider and approve the Refund Policy for cancellation of M.Tech. admissions through CCMT - 2017 in academic year 2017-18

The Senate approved the "Cancellation and Refund Policy" of CCMT 2017 as proposed in the agenda.

S 30.08 To note the visit and report of External Peer Review Committee to the Department of Business Administration

The Senate noted the report of External Peer Review Committee of the Department of Business Administration which visited the department on May 20, 2017. The Senate was apprised that the Director has directed the Department of Business Administration to chalk out an Action Plan based on the report.

**S 30.09**

To consider modification in the academic rules for promotion to higher semester of the B.Tech programme of the Institute.

The Senate approved the proposal of modification in the academic rules for promotion to higher semester of B. Tech programme of the institute as proposed in the agenda. This will be applicable to the students admitted in the Institute from the academic section 2017-18 batch onwards. The final decision is presented in the tabular form as below:

The Senate decided that the maximum duration for completing the B.Tech. program shall be eight years. Further, the Senate desired that this information be made part of the Students' Handbook so as to communicate it to the students for their awareness.

S 30.10

To consider proposed criteria for the Best All Round Student (Boys/Girls)

The Senate considered the criteria for the Best All Round Student as proposed by a committee constituted by the Director and as placed in the agenda. The report was discussed in detail and accepted with the following modifications:

Eligibility Criteria:

1. The student should have obtained a minimum of 7.0 CGPA in the B.Tech. Program.
2. The student should have passed each examination of the program in the first attempt.
3. The student should have achievements in all the activities and should be scoring non-zero points individually in each of the activities and sub-activities.



4. The student who has been awarded punishment for a major indiscipline would not be eligible for consideration for the award.

S 30.12

The issue was taken up as a follow-up of requests of four Ph.D. candidates who could not submit their Ph.D. thesis during the stipulated period of seven years and had requested for extension.

The issue was considered and largely deliberated upon. Finally, it was resolved that all such cases who have completed the maximum duration of seven years of Ph.D. but have not submitted the Ph.D. thesis, stand deregistered. It was decided that a Committee be constituted to frame rules for re-registration for such cases. However, these candidates are allowed to re-register for Ph.D. The Senate authorized the Director to constitute the Committee.

The Senate in its 30th meeting held on 6.6.2017 vide item no. 30.04 approved the proposal of criteria of minimum requirement of attendance for being eligible to appear in the end semester examinations as given below:

Minimum requirement of attendance for being eligible to appear in the end semester shall be 75%.

However, this may be relaxed upto a maximum of 10% i.e. upto 65% by the director. Those having attendance below 65% are not allowed to appear for the end-semester examination of that/those course (s) and shall be notified as 'Detained'. All such students, depending upon their attendance shall be further categorized into two categories A & B, as follows:

Category A: (Attendance between 50 % to 64 %) A student has two options

Option 1: To repeat the course through classroom/lab studies and obtain whatever grade he can obtain

Option 2: He/She is permitted to attend classes of the next semester and can appear for the mid-semester examinations of that/those course(s) when the opportunity is available. However, such student is restricted to a grade of 'D' only.

Category B: (Attendance below 50 %) Such students have to mandatorily repeat that/those course (s)



- 30.05.1 Possible shortcomings in the existing rule of re-evaluation.
- 30.05.2 Continuance/Discontinuance of the procedure of re-evaluation.

For 30.05.1, it was decided that if the re-evaluated marks change the status of a student in that paper from "Fail to Pass", it will be considered, even though the change in marks may be less than 15%. This shall also apply to the existing candidates whose cases are under consideration presently.

For 30.05.2, it was decided to discontinue the practice of re-evaluation in future. However, the following practice of appeal in force shall continue.

A student not satisfied with his marks may approach the faculty. If satisfied, ok.

If not satisfied, he/she can approach the coordinator of that course. If satisfied, ok.

If not satisfied, the student may approach the Head of the Department and request the Head of the Department in writing. Head of the Department may constitute a committee of 2-3 faculty. The decision of the committee will be final and binding.

Some M.Tech students of the Institute have requested to grant/continue scholarship on the basis of SGPA/CGPA as per CCMT guidelines whereas the GATE scholarship to the M. Tech students of the Institute is being granted as per rules, terms and conditions of the Govt. of India, MHRD, New Delhi issued from time to time. The relevant Clause (d) regarding continuation of GATE Scholarship as per MHRD letter No. F.18-42/96.TS.III dated 17.9.98 is as under :-

"The student must secure a first class or equivalent, CGPA/Grade during the first semester and the second semester examinations to become eligible for continuance of scholarship at the enhanced rate during the second semester and the third semester respectively. Scholarship once discontinued will not be continued again, even if a student secures first class or equivalent CGPA/Grade after second semester".

Thereafter the scholarship amount has been enhanced from time to time by the MHRD, but the rules for continuation of scholarship have not been changed.

According to CCMT-2016 guidelines, the minimum eligibility condition for M.Tech admission in terms of CGPA/CGPI or % marks and stipend is as under:-

Minimum eligibility is 6.0 CGPA/CGPI on 10 point scale or 55% marks for SC/ST/PWD candidates and 6.5 CGPA/CGPI on 10 scale or 60% marks for OC/OBC candidates.

As per MHRD guidelines the admitted candidates through CCMT-2016 will be getting a stipend of Rs. 12,400/- month (which is changeable time to time as per MHRD directions) in condition they have to maintain their CGPA 6 and above (for SC & ST) and 6.5 and above for rest of the categories" (Copy attached).

Similarly in CCMT-2017 guidelines also, the category-wise minimum eligibility criteria in terms of CGPA/CGPI or % marks and stipend is as under:-

Further as per MHRD guidelines the admitted candidates through CCMT-2017 will be getting a stipend of Rs. 12,400/- month (which is changeable time to time as per MHRD directions) in condition they have to maintain their CGPA 6 and above (for SC&ST) and 6.5 and above for rest of the categories CCMT-2017 (Copy attached).




- d. For academic purpose all norms of the NIT Kurukshetra will be applicable to the candidate and supervisor(s).



The provision of recontinuation of GATE scholarship exists in many NITs (pages 36 to 39). Keeping above facts under consideration, it is proposed to restore the M.Tech. GATE scholarship (from the day) when eligibility for GATE scholarship is reattained.

As per SCSA 52.1 (ii), the Senate may kindly decide on recontinuation of GATE scholarship to M.Tech students once it is discontinued due to lower CGPA or reappear in previous semesters.

2.7 Attendance Rule

- 2.7.1 All students must attend every class and 100% attendance is expected from the students. However, in consideration of the constraints/ unavoidable circumstances, the attendance can be relaxed by course coordinator only to the extent of not more than 25%. Every student must attend minimum of 75% of the classes actually held for that course.
- 2.7.2 A student with less than 75% attendance in a course during the semester, will be awarded W grade. Such a student will not be eligible to appear for the end semester and re-examination of that course. Even if such a student happens to appear for these examinations, then, answer books of such students will not be evaluated.
- 2.7.3 A student with W grade is not eligible to appear for Re-examination and summer term also.
- 2.7.4 Students will be informed about their attendance status after the 1st and 2nd sessional examinations.

2.8 Additional rules for M.Tech / M.Sc

2.8.1 Leave policy

A full-time M. Tech. Student during his/her stay at the Institute will be entitled for 30 days leave (including leave on medical grounds) per academic year. Full time M. Tech. Students do not have vacation. Even during mid-semester breaks and summer and winter vacations, he/she will have to explicitly apply for leave. He/she, however, may be permitted to avail leave only up to 15 days during winter vacation at the end of the first semester. The leave will be subjected to approval of the Head of Department concerned and the department concerned shall be responsible for maintaining proper leave account of each student.

2.8.2 Assistantship Requirements

M. Tech. student irrespective of the source of assistantship must attend at least 75 % of classes in each course in which he/she is registered. In case his/her attendance falls below 75 % in any course during a month, he/she will not be paid assistantship for that month. Further, if his/her attendance again falls short of 75 % in any course in any subsequent month in that semester, his/her studentship and assistantship will be terminated.

All students who are offered assistantship are expected to put in 8 hours per week towards the work assigned by the Department / Faculty.

Continuation of assistantship in a subsequent semester would be subject to the condition of obtaining a satisfactory academic performance and assigned task. If CGPA of a student falls below 6.75, then, his/her stipend will be reduced. However, in the subsequent semesters, if student improves the CGPA equal to or above 6.75, then, stipend will be restored, only after a gap of one semester.

If student gets FF grade in one or two courses, then, stipend will be reduced. As and when student will credit that course with pass grade, then, stipend will be restored only after a gap of one semester.

one student of a program, i.e. if there is a tie, SGPA of previous semesters will be considered till the tie is broken.

2. Endowment Gold Medals: These medals are awarded by donors to students in appreciation of their academic performance. The rules and procedures are to be approved by the Senate in case-to-case basis. If the highest CGPA is secured by more than one student of a program, i.e. if there is a tie, SGPA of previous semesters will be considered till the tie is broken.

In case the highest CGPA student(s), in a particular branch(s), could not clear all papers in single chance or been awarded punishment by the Institute's Disciplinary Committee, no other student(s) will be awarded with Institute Gold Medal for that branch(s). Similarly, Institute Gold Medal for Best Graduate will not be awarded to others on above ground.

- 13.7 On publication of final results a student will be issued a provisional certificate signed by Dean (Academic) on behalf of the Director. The final degree will be signed by the Chairman, Senate and Chairman, Board of Governors.

14 Scholarship

- 14.1 M. Tech students admitted through CCMT are entitled to get scholarship governed by the rules of MHRD.
- 14.2 All students receiving scholarship will be required to assist the Department in teaching activity (sessional, laboratory etc.) and other academic activity; the quantum of such contribution being decided by the administration from time to time. However, HOD shall ensure that due to such assignment the students do not miss their classes.
- 14.3 If a student remains unsuccessful in a semester examination, the scholarship will be immediately stopped. However, the same will be restored as and when he /she passes the examination.
- 14.4 If a student abandons his study prematurely he will be required to surrender the scholarship received, without interest. In case of being terminated due to poor performance, normally there shall be no recovery. But, if the DPAC is convinced that the student consciously performed poorly only to avoid paying back the fellowship received, it can still recommend recovery of the fellowship paid. In both cases, the institute will normally not pursue the recovery, e.g. through a law court, but will deny certificates and other privileges if requested by the student.
- 14.5 A student remained absent without sanctioned leave will entail loss of scholarship for the period of absence and may result in the termination of the students' program.

15 Exceptions & Dispute Resolution

- 15.1 Notwithstanding anything stated in the rules, the Senate can make special provisions and exceptions depending on the merit of a case. Such cases shall not be cited as precedence in future occasions of similar nature.
- 15.2 In emergency situations, the Director in capacity of the Chairman of the Senate, can exercise powers of the senate and discharge the functions of the Senate. Such decisions must be reported to the Senate at its next meeting.
- 15.3 Whenever a dispute arises regarding interpretation of one or more provisions of these rules, the matter shall be referred to the Board and the interpretation given by the Board shall be considered correct and final.

1. Addition in clause 2.7:

- (iv) Refund of Stipend/ Institute fund: in case if a student leave the PG program or discontinue the program in between, for any reason, Scholarship shall be discontinued. Also he/she has to refund all the amount received from the institute directly in the form of stipend and indirectly in the form of support for activities such as participation in conference, sports etc.
An undertaking stating this condition needs to be signed by the candidate at the time of admission. The maximum duration for availing the stipend shall be two years from the date of admission.

2. Addition in clause 3.6:

- (vii) If the candidates leave the program after two/three Semester for job, the minimum duration for course completion will be six/five semesters respectively, with due registration.

3. Modification in Clause 6.6: Academic Performance Requirement

The minimum SGPA requirement for continuing in the programme is 5.5 for M.Tech./ M.Plant/ MBA/ MCA.

4. Addition in clause 6.6: Fellowship on backlog

- (iv) If a candidate has backlog or SGPA below 5.5, scholarship shall be discontinued and will resume from the date of clearing backlog/ maintaining SGPA 5.5 (no arrears will be paid).

The SCSA in its 45th meeting held on 29.8.2013 (minutes of 45th SCSA meeting are enclosed from (pages 41 to 43) [Item 45.1 (at Point-2)] decided that the candidate will be allowed to work at the external organization for six months in the 4th semester only. However, during 3rd semester, the candidate shall be allowed to work at the external organization for 30 days typically in the stretches of two weeks each. Not more than 25% of the students in the concerned M.Tech program will be allowed to do their dissertation at the external organization.

One of the M.Tech 3rd semester student of Embedded System Design requested for 11 months internship in KPIT Tech. Ltd. His case was placed before the SCSA in its 52nd meeting held on 13.8.2017. The SCSA considered his request (copy enclosed from (pages 44 to 46).

Keeping in view the placement scenario of M.Tech. students and to enhance the industry institute interaction, the Senate may consider the above decision of the 52nd SCSA meeting for all M.Tech students as a policy matter, as per the conditions decided or with some modifications.

Item 45.1: To decide the policy for permitting M.Tech students to do their dissertation work at Central/State Govt. labs. /Institutions

The SCSA considered the matter and decided as under:-

The M.Tech students may be permitted to do their dissertation work at Central/State Govt. laboratories/Institutions/R&D sections of reputed companies

preferably multi-nationals (henceforth referred as external organizations) subject to the following conditions:

1. The concerned HOD shall ensure that for the research topic for dissertation chosen by the candidate, the department has some facilities to support the research work.
2. The candidate will be allowed to work at the external organization for six months in the 4th semester only. However, during 3rd semester, the candidate shall be allowed to work at the external organization for 30 days typically in the stretches of two weeks each. Not more than 25% of the students in the concerned M.Tech program will be allowed to do their dissertation at the external organization.
3. There will be one Co-guide from the proposed institution where the dissertation work is to be done. A written consent of the Co-guide for guiding the dissertation work at his/her organization should be submitted to the Academic Section through research Supervisor(s) and concerned HOD along with tentative title of the dissertation.
4. The GATE qualified candidates may be allowed to draw scholarship subject to the following conditions:
 - The student shall submit a certificate from his Co-guide to the effect that he has worked satisfactorily for his dissertation work at the organization with details of leaves availed, if any, every month.
 - The GATE qualified candidate shall submit a monthly Progress Report signed by Co-guide/Guide. The IPR, if any, shall be shared by the guides and the student.
5. The student shall abide by all rules and regulations for evaluation of his dissertation work as stipulated in the M.Tech scheme/syllabi as approved by the Senate.





Item 52.1: To modify norms for continuation of GATE scholarship to M.Tech. students based on CGPA on the basis of requests received from M.Tech. students.

Keeping in view the norms and guidelines issued time to time, various issues as raised by Dean (Academic) related to M.Tech GATE scholarship were discussed & decided as:

- i) For the award and continuation of M.Tech GATE scholarship, CGPA/SGPA for various categories is to be adopted as per the guidelines issued by CCMT, time to time. However, other conditions are to be maintained as per MHRD norms.
- ii) Issues related to re-continuation of Scholarship after a break was discussed and keeping in view the discussions held in the meeting, matter is to be taken up in the forthcoming Senate meeting as an agenda item.

Item 52.2 To consider the case of internship of M.Tech students.

1. Request of Mr Ankit Sharma an M.Tech 3rd semester student of embedded system design, regarding the 11 month internship in KPIT Tech. Ltd. was discussed. All members expressed their views and after long deliberations, KPIT Tech. Ltd. internships were approved, subject to the following conditions.
 - a. There should be two supervisors, one internal (from parent department) and one external (from the concerned industry). Consent of internal supervisor is mandatory. Topic of dissertation to be decided by mutual consent of supervisors. In case of interdisciplinary area, one more internal supervisor from relevant department may be opted.
 - b. No scholarship will be provided by the institute for M.Tech 3rd & 4th Semesters.
 - c. External supervisor is required to maintain the attendance of the candidate & it should be at least 75 % per semester. It is to be communicated to the concerned department, on monthly basis.




- d. For academic purpose all norms of the NIT Kurukshetra will be applicable to the candidate and supervisor(s).
 - e. Candidate is required to appear for viva-voce/presentation as and when required by the parent department, along with the dissertation work.
 - f. All publications from the dissertation work will be in the name of candidate and all supervisors. Copyright, trademark and patent from the dissertation work, will be jointly in the names of NIT Kurukshetra and concerned industry.
 - g. At the end of internship, candidate is required to submit the hard and soft copies of dissertation work, duly signed by the supervisor(s), in the parent department, by due date. Final examination will be conducted by the parent department as per NIT Kurukshetra norms.
2. Many views were given by the respective members, for implementing such internships from Govt. /Academic sectors to all M.Tech students, in future. However, after long deliberations, it was resolved that matter may be taken up in the forthcoming senate meeting as an agenda item.

He has submitted the fee for all the semester extensions with registration upto July 2017.

His thesis supervisor has submitted a report (page 50) on the status and quality of work done by the student.

The relevant academic rule 5.0 regarding Absence/Dropping of semester is as under (pages 51 to 52).

***5.0 Absence/Dropping of Semester**

5.1 If a student absents from the Institute with due permission of the Dean Academic due to illness, he/she will be permitted to rejoin provided the period of absence does not exceed one semester. If the period of absence is more than one semester or the absence is for reasons other than illness, the case will be referred to the Director by Dean Academic Affairs with his/her recommendations.

The student will, however, be charged the prescribed fee even for the period of absence. In no case, the total period of absence shall exceed two semesters during student's stay in the Institute. In that eventuality, the student's name shall be struck off from the rolls of the Institute.

5.2 In case a student absents from the Institute without prior permission, he/she may be permitted to join back with the permission of the Director on payment of penalty of ₹ 10,000/- in addition to the prescribed fee for the period of absence. In no case, the period of unauthorized absence will exceed one semester. If the period of unauthorized absence exceeds one semester, the student's name will be struck off from the rolls of the Institute.

A student will be allowed to study the courses as defined by a department carrying prescribed credits. The total period of stay at the Institute for award of M.Tech degree will not, in any case, exceed 5 years (Ten semesters).

5.5 Appeal

Notwithstanding the above, the Senate may at its discretion on appeal, relax any of the conditions of Clause 5.1 and 5.2"

The above student is of 2012-14 batch. His 5 years have been completed in July, 2017.

As per Clause 5.5, the Senate may consider and decide the case.



Report on the status and quality of work done by the student

It has been reported that the M-Tech. student (Roll No. 3127006), has done an excellent research work on the topic of "*An experimental investigation of Concentrated Solar Power (CSP) using convex lenses for water heating system*". He, under my guidance, has invented a new "Concentrated Solar Power Collector with Convex Lenses for Water and Air Heating". This invention relates to the utilization of solar energy using closed Hemi-cylindrical Solar Heat Collector, which fulfills the gap between conventional Flat Plate Collector (FPC) and Concentrated Collector. The glazing of FPC has been replaced by an array of convex lenses, which concentrate the solar radiations on absorbing plate for generation of hot water or air by the natural thermo-syphon principal.

It is worth mention here that earlier the student had been doing his dissertation work under the guidance of Dr. Sudhir Saxena (Retd. Professor, Mech. Engg. Dept.), later on, he started doing his dissertation work under my guidance after the retirement of Dr. Saxena, with the approval of the co-ordinator (School of Renewable Energy and Efficiency).

Further, the work assigned to the student by me was with the aim of the new invention, for which a patent would be filed, and the student performed very well. At present, we are in the process of filing a patent on the same invention.

The student has completed his experimental and analysis work and the thesis report is ready to be submitted.

Where C_i denotes credits assigned to i th course and G_i indicates the Grade point equivalent to the Letter Grade obtained by the student to the i th course.

Provide that when a student repeats a course, the new Grade will replace the earlier one in the calculations of the CGPA.

Note :

The Percentage of marks obtained by a student if so required, can be calculated as=CGPA multiplied by 9.00.

- 4.2** At the end of each semester (i.e. after End Semester Examination), students will be supplied a Grade Card indicating the Grade secured in each course and up to date CGPA.

- 4.3** A Student is deemed to have completed the requirements for graduation and is eligible for the award of degree if :

- (a) he/she has satisfied all the academic requirements as per the regulations.
- (b) he/she has paid all fees due from him/her.
- (c) there is no case of indiscipline pending against him/her.

5.0 Absence/Dropping of Semester

- 5.1** If a student absents from the Institute with due permission of the Dean Academic due to illness, he/she will be permitted to rejoin provided the period of absence does not exceed one semester. If the period of absence

is more than one semester or the absence is for reasons other than illness, the case will be referred to the Director by Dean Academic Affairs with his/her recommendations.

The student will, however, be charged the prescribed fee even for the period of absence. In no case, the total period of absence shall exceed two semesters during student's stay in the Insitute. In that evertuality, the student's name shall struck off from the rolls of the Insitute.

5.2 In case a student absents from the Institute without prior permission, he/she may be permitted to join back with the permission of the Director on payment of penalty or Rs. 10,000/- in addition to the prescribed fee for the period of absence.

In no case, the period of unauthorized absence will exceed one semester. If the period of unauthorized absence exceeds one semester, the student's name will be struck off from the rolls of the Insitute.

A student will be allowed to study the courses as defined by a department carrying prescribed credits. The total period of stay at the Insitute for award of M.Tech. degree will not, in any case, exceed 5 years (Ten Semesters).

5.3 The gap in studies, if any, will count towards the total duration of the Programme permissible under the Regulations.

5.4 The minimum CGPA required for the award of degree is 5.50. If a student after obtaining pass Grades (A/B/C/D) in all courses at the end of the programme obtains a CGPA less than minimum CGPA = 5.5 required for the award of degree, he/she may be allowed by Dean Academic to improve the CGPA by studying the course(s) in which he/she has earned 'D' Grade(s) provided the said courses are offered in the semester under consideration of additional semester(s) for improvement will be counted within maximum duration permissible for the programme.

5.5 Appeal

Notwithstanding the above, the Senate may at its discretion on appeal, relax any of the conditions of Caluse 5.1 and 5.2

Item 31.7 To consider and decide norms for change of branch to B.Tech. students.

The Senate in its 3rd meeting held on 26.5.2004 (pages 54 to 57) allowed change of branch to B.Tech students in 3rd semester on the basis of CGPA obtained in first year of their study, subject to the condition that the number of students in a particular branch does not fall below 75% of the sanctioned strength. In case of tie, the rank in the AIEEE/JEE (Mains) may be considered as tie breaker. If there are some cases of tie, the break-up of marks obtaining 10+2 qualifying examination may be taken into account to break the tie.

This year during branch change of B.Tech. 2016 batch, two students of PIE branch made representation to the Director that due to existing branch rule of 75% of the sanctioned strength, they are not eligible for branch change even though they are top rankers in their branch based on CGPA of first year. The representation of the students are enclosed from (pages 58 to 59).

The Senate in its 30th meeting held on 6.6.2017 approved new scheme and syllabi for B.Tech. programmes w.e.f. academic session 2017-18. In new scheme, the students of B.Tech. 1st and 2nd semester of all programmes have to study some branch specific courses also.

In view of above, the Senate may kindly decide on (i) the representation of the students for branch change at this stage and (ii). The modalities for change of branch for B.Tech. 2017 batch onward.

If there is still some case of tie, the percentage of marks obtained in +2 qualifying examination may be taken into account to break the tie.

Item 31.8 To consider and decide mercy chance to appear for backlogs for the students who have completed maximum duration of their respective degree programmes.

As per academic regulations, the maximum duration in which a student must qualify for the award of UG and PG degrees are as follows:

B.Tech. Programme:	8 years
M.Tech. Programme:	5 years
MBA Programme:	4 years
MCA Programme:	6 years

The students of B.Tech. 2009 batch have already completed maximum duration to complete their respective degrees. Some of the students have requested to give them a mercy chance so that they can clear re-appear papers and become eligible to receive respective degrees. The request of these students and their backlog data are enclosed from (pages 66 to 80).

At the time of Institute's Golden Jubilee Celebrations, the Senate in its 22nd meeting held on 10th April 2013 vide item no. 22.3 allowed the students to appear in theory/practical/sessional exams to the students who could not pass their degree in the maximum duration of the course. Other modalities of mercy chance to the students are enclosed from (pages 81 to 86). The Institute allowed B.Tech. 2007 batch a mercy chance in Special Re-appear Exam. conducted in July/August 2015 (page 87) with a condition that the student should be having only one re-appear in any of the semester so that they can clear their re-appear and become eligible to receive respective degrees. In 2016 (page 88), B.Tech. 2008 batch, M.Tech. 2011 batch, MBA 2011 batch and MCA 2010 batch were also given mercy chance with a condition that they have few re-appears in any of the semester so that they can clear their re-appear and become eligible to receive respective degrees.

It is proposed to conduct the special examinations for the backlogs for the students who have completed maximum duration of their degree programmes, during the sessions May/June 2018 & Nov./Dec. 2018. This schedule may be helpful to inform the concerned students well in time & further provides sufficient time for the exam. preparations.

In view of above, the Senate may kindly consider on modalities of mercy change for the students of all UG & PG programmes who have completed maximum duration of their respective degree programmes.



The Academic Section has received some applications from B.Tech students who have completed 8 years in the program and still have some subjects in which they need to re-appear in the end semester examinations. As per the existing rules, their registration in the program is automatically terminated after the expiry of 8 years in the program. 

Item 31.9 To decide Institute fee to be charged from the students repeating semester courses due to detention and other reasons.

The Institute allows to repeat semesters to the students for the courses in which they were detained during their regular study in every semester on the request of the students and the approval given by the Dean (Acad.). Such students are to be charged prescribed institute fee applicable for their batch for that semester.

It is pertinent to mention that these students have already paid their prescribed institute fee in their regular study. These students also not allowed to take part in the institute activities, hence the fee charged from them seems to be higher side. In some cases, students studied only one/two or few courses in the semester and has been charged full institute fee. The concerned students and their parents also approached the Dean (Academic) for relaxation of fee.

Some students were allowed to repeat semesters/courses in even semester of academic session 2016-17 with the permission of the Dean (Academic). While issuing the office order, the students were informed that they have to pay institute fee as decided by the Competent Authority. The approval and the office order of such students are enclosed from (pages **91** to **103**). It was decided by the then Dean (Academic) to place this issue in the next Senate meeting as agenda item, but it could not be placed. Fee collection from such students is still pending.

In view of above, it is proposed that the fee from above students may be charged as per following formula:

$$\text{Fee} = \{(\text{Tuition fee})/(\text{No. of courses})\} \times \text{Repeat Courses}$$

Tuition Fee	The tuition fee applicable to his batch in the respective semester
No. of Courses	No. of courses in the respective semester including all theory/ practical/project etc. courses
Repeat Courses	No. of courses in which the student was having detention and decided to repeat these courses to get normal grade

In addition to this fees, the student need to pay hostel room rent as per availability and allotment to him/her and other miscellaneous expenses during his study in that semester.

The Senate may kindly consider the above proposal and approve the proposed fee to be charged from such students.
