Item 15.1: To confirm the minutes of the 14th meeting of the Senate held on 14.03.2010

Item 15.2: To note the Action Taken Report on the minutes of the 14th meeting of the Senate held on 14.03.2010

The Senate noted the actions taken on the minutes of the 14th meeting of the Senate held on 14.03.2010 as per details furnished in the agenda item.

Professor Incharge (Academic) apprised the members that as per decision taken under item 14.2, an agenda item will be placed in the next meeting of Finance Committee for increasing remuneration of External Examiner for evaluating M.Tech. Dissertation and Indian External Examiner for evaluating Ph.D. Thesis.

Lengthy discussion took place in the Senate meeting while noting the action taken report on Items 14.3 and 14.4 regarding nomination of one Professor and one Associate Professor or Assistant Professor on the Board of Governors. Lot of views were expressed about continuation of existing Senate Nominees on the Board of Governors beyond their tenure of two years. The Registrar-cum-Secretary, Senate informed the members that the matter has been referred to MHRD and notification to this regard is expected shortly.

The Registrar-cum-Secretary, Senate informed the members that as per decision taken under item 14.8, an agenda item was placed in the 15th meeting the Finance Committee. The Finance Committee decided that the practice of awarding two Dr. R P Singh medals be continued and any shortfall in funds be met from Institute funds.

Item 15.3: To consider and approve decisions taken in 28th and 29th meetings of Standing Committee on Senate Affairs (SCSA)

The Senate considered the decisions taken in the 28th and 29th meetings of Standing Committee on Senate Affairs.

While considering the decision taken under Item 1 of the 28th SCSA meeting regarding recommendations submitted by the Committee constituted for reviewing the existing Ph.D. Ordinance of the Institute, the Senate decided that the required regular service under Clause R-3.1 i) (b) be reduced from 15 years to 10 years. This change be made effective for Ph.D. admissions from Session 2011-2012.

Apart from this change, the Senate approved the decisions taken in the 28th and 29th meetings of Standing Committee on Senate Affairs.
