The list of activities and the guidelines under CPDA are given below.

List of Activities:

1. Attending / participation in National / International Conferences in India / Abroad
2. Papers publishing in National / International Conference / Journals
3. Visit to Indian / Foreign University for technical discussion
4. Acquiring membership of Professional Societies, both National as well as International
5. Purchasing books and subscription to Journals
6. Visit to technical exhibitions
7. Upgradation of computers, purchasing computers/laptops, web / digital cameras, monitor/scan / multifunctional printers
8. Participating in course material preparation / teaching aids
9. Book writing
10. Purchase of software and /or data base upgradation
11. Upgradation / Repair of meeting equipment / experimental set-up
12. Office furniture & furnishing, office equipment / air conditioners etc.
13. Any other items with prior approval of the Director

Guidelines:

1. Attending / Participating in National / International Conferences in India or Abroad or visit to Indian / Foreign University requires approval of the Director. The allowance can be utilized towards the following:
 - (a) Travel cost (TADA)
 - (b) Payment of registration fee / course fee
 - (c) Visa fee (if any)
 - (d) Medical insurance
 - (e) Boarding and lodging charges
 - (f) Any items admissible

2. Period of absence not to exceed 2 weeks during teaching days in an academic year and to include during vacation as long as the period does not exceed the duration of vacation. However, the Director can sleep for permission in case of exigencies.
3. An advance may be admissible for CPDR activities as per Institute Rules.
4. The reimbursement may be made within a month after the submission of claims. The claim to be submitted within a month after the activity.
5. The expenditure to the tune of Rs. 1 Lac per year be planned. Unspent balance will be carried over to the next block year commencing for the full remaining period of the block. In case the expenditure exceeds one lakh in a year, the extra excess amount would be adjusted in the next block year with due approval.
6. No prior financial approval is required for expenditure on the activities listed above, but the existing Institute Rules will be applicable for reimbursement of expenditure.
7. Expenditure towards the purchase of books shall not exceed Rs. 10000/- in a financial year. Purchase of books costing more than Rs. 15,000/- shall require prior approval of the Director.
8. Reimbursement for TA/DA is as per the actual bill of hotel, food & local travel shall be as per Institute norms.
9. The first block starts from 1st October 2010 and will be ending on 31st March, 2012.
10. The expenditure on the activities listed above is to be recorded and is auditable. The faculty member will be responsible for clarifying such objections, if any.
11. The claims for reimbursement are required to be submitted to the Returns enclosed herewith.




