Item 23.3: To note decisions taken in 43rd, 44th & 45th meeting of Standing Committee on Senate Affairs (SCSA)

- (a) In the Ordinances and Regulations for the Degree of Doctor of Philosophy at R-2 (iii), the words about 2 years may be replaced by 2 years mentioned at page 41 of the agenda.
- (b) In the Ordinances and Regulations for the Degree of Doctor of Philosophy at R-3.2 (i), the words <u>Assistant Professor or equivalent in an</u> <u>engineering degree level</u> may be replaced by <u>Assistant Professor or</u> <u>equivalent in the sponsoring engineering degree level.</u>

Item 23.4: To consider and approve the generalized annual academic calendar

(a) The word <u>non-academic</u> may be replaced by <u>extra curricular</u> in line 4 of the agenda item mentioned at page 69.

(b) The word <u>class test</u> may be replaced by <u>mid semester</u> in the general academic calendar mentioned at page 70 of the agenda.

Item 23.5: To consider scheme and syllabus for M. Tech. in Biomedical Engineering.

The Senate considered and approved the scheme and syllabii for M. Tech. in Biomedical Engineering with the following amendments:

- (a) The scheme of M. Tech. in Biomedical Engineering may be signed by the coordinator on each page.
- (b) The course code for seminar-II may be replaced by BME-514P mentioned in Annexure-I for second semester scheme given at page 73 of the agenda. Further, a note may be included in second semester scheme indicating that there is no end semester examination for seminar.
- (c) The scheme of M. Tech. 3rd semester in Bio-Medical engineering should be strictly in accordance with the structure of M. Tech. program as approved by the Senate in its 20th meeting held on 10.05.2012.
- (d) In the Note II of the Fourth semester scheme for the award of grade A to dissertation, the words good quality paper may be replaced by scoupus/1SI indexed journals. Further, the foot note marked (*) may be replaced with peer reviewed conference organized by IISc/IIT/NIT/ a premier R & D organization/professional societies.
- (e) For the award of Grade B, the word <u>International conference</u> may be replaced with <u>International/National conference</u>.
- (f) The words <u>non-credit based dissertation evaluation</u> underlined in the proposed scheme may be deleted.

Item23.6: To consider scheme and Syllabus for M. Tech. in Material Science and Nanotechnology

The Senate considered and approved the scheme and syllabus for M. Tech. in Material science and Nanotechnology with the following amendments:

- (a) The scheme of M. Tech. in Material science and Nanotechnology be signed by the coordinator on each page.
- (b) The course code for seminar-II may be replaced by MNT-514P mentioned in for second semester scheme given at page 84 of the agenda. Further, a note may be included in second semester scheme indicating that there is no end semester examination for seminar.
- (c) The scheme of M. Tech. 3rd semester in Material Science and Nanotechnology should be strictly in accordance with the structure of M. Tech. program as approved by the Senate in its 20th meeting held on 10.05.2012.
- (d) In the Note II of the Fourth semester scheme for the award of grade A to dissertation, the words good quality paper may be replaced by scoupus/1SI indexed journals. Further, the foot note marked (*) may be replaced with peer reviewed conference organized by IISc/IIT/NIT/ a premier R & D organization/professional societies.
- (e) For the award of Grade B, the word <u>International conference</u> may be replaced with <u>International/National conference</u>.
- (f) The words non-credit based dissertation evaluation underlined in the proposed scheme may be deleted.
