



S 42.11 To consider the proposal of establishment of Best All-Round Student Awards by Alumni Association.

The Secretary, NIT Kurukshetra Alumni Association (NITKAA) requested the Dean (I&IR) vide letter ref.no. NITKAA/2021/146 dated April 06, 2021 regarding Establishment of Best All-Round Student Awards (copy enclosed).

The NITKAA in its Executive Committee meetings held on 31st January 2021 and 28th March, 2021 at NITKAA office, NIT Kurukshetra resolved to establish the Best All-Round Student Awards. These awards will be in addition to already existing Institute award for Best All Round UG students (Boys/Girls). For this, a cheque of Rs. 25,000/ and a gold medal in the name of late Mr. Raj Ranjan Patnaik, alumnus of 1980-85 batch, will be given to Best All-Round Student (Male). A financial contribution of Rs. Six Lakhs received from 1980-85 batch has been kept in the form of FDR in the NITKAA bank account.

Similarly, a cheque of Rs. 25,000/ and a gold medal in the name of 1990-94 batch alumni will be given to Best All-Round student (Female). A financial contribution of Rs. Six Lakhs received from 1990-94 batch has been kept in the form of FDR in the NITKAA bank account.

It is also proposed to give a cheque of Rs. 25,000/- and a gold medal in the name of late Ms. Nupur Jain to Best All-Round student –Differently abled (PwD). For this, a financial contribution of Rs. Six Lakhs has been received from an alumnus from 2K batch.

The annual interest from the respective FDRs kept for the purposes shall be utilized for giving away the cheque amount and the gold medal during annual Convocation of the respective batch to be made effective from academic session 2021-22.

It was further resolved that for deciding Best All Round Student Award under PwD category, the Institute may constitute a Committee to frame the procedure/guidelines.

The Senate may consider and decide on the proposal of NITKAA.

Subject: Establishment of Best All-round Student Awards regarding;

This is in reference to the meetings of the Executive Committee of the NIT Kurukshetra Alumni Association (NITKAA) held on Sunday, 31st January, 2021 and 28th March, 2021 at NITKAA office Kurukshetra. The Executive Committee has resolved and submit the following:

A financial contribution of Rs Six (06) lakhs has been received from 1980-85 batch a few months back and has been kept in the form of FDR. It has been proposed to establish a cheque amount of Rs. 25,000/- and a gold medal in the name of late Mr Raj Ranjan Patnaik for the Best All-Round student of the Batch -MALE [UG]. Mr Raj Ranjan Patnaik was an alumnus of 1980-85 batch, who left for the heavenly abode during the COVID times.

Similarly, a financial contribution of Rs. Six (06) lakhs has been received from 1990-94 batch and has been kept in the form of FDR. It has been proposed to establish a cheque amount of Rs. 25,000/- and a gold medal for the Best All-Round student of the Batch -FEMALE [UG]. Also, a financial contribution of Rs. Six (06) lakhs has been committed by Mr. Saurabh Jain, an alumnus from 2K batch and it has been proposed to establish Nupur Jain Excellence Award in the name of late Ms. Nupur jain for the Best All-Round student of the Batch – Differently abled [UG], which will consist of a cheque amount of Rs. 25,000/- and a Gold medal.

It is pertinent to mention that the annual interest from the respective FDRs kept for the purposes shall be utilized for giving away the cheque amount and the gold medal during annual Convocation of the respective batch to be made effective from academic session 2022-23. Also, we have been given understanding that the institute has an established procedure for the selection of Best All-Round student of the Batch - MALE & FEMALE every year. Further, it was also resolved in the last EC meeting that the institute authorities may be requested to adopt the similar procedure/guidelines for Best All-Round student of the Batch-differently abled category also.
