The same was notified vide notification no. Acad/21/533 dated 03.05.2021 (copy enclosed).

The SCSA in its 60<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 18.10.2021 vide agenda item no. 60.02 noted the decision of Ministry of Education, Govt. of India to waive off the eligibility condition of JEE (Mains) score/rank for admission in B.Tech. programs of the Institute under MEA Scheme for Academic Year 2021-22.

The admission on MEA scheme in B.Tech. programs of the Institute for Academic Year 2021-22 will therefore be made on the basis of valid SAT-II score only. However, from the Academic Year 2022-23 onwards, the admissions on MEA quota shall be based on the score/ranks secured by the aspiring students in the Joint Entrance Examination (Main) conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA) as per letter no. F.No. 37-3/2021-TS.III dated 30<sup>th</sup> July, 2021 (copy enclosed).

The Foreign Nationals (FN) studying in any country including India, Persons of Indian Origins (PIO), Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) and Non-resident of India (NRI) who fulfill prescribed admission criteria are hereby informed that admission in B.Tech. Programs of NIT Kurukshetra under DASA scheme shall be made on the basis of rank/merit in JEE (Main) examination conducted by NTA for Academic Year 2021-22 onwards.

The Institute also offers admissions in B.Tech. programs under MEA, SII scheme of MoE as per admission criteria of DASA scheme. Therefore, the eligible applicants who wish to study B.Tech. Programs under MEA, SII scheme are also informed that the admission in B.Tech. Programs of NIT Kurukshetra from Academic Year 2021-22 will also be based on rank/merit secured in JEE (Main) examination conducted by NTA.

In addition to above, the applicant must pass English as a subject in his/her school education at least at the level of 10<sup>th</sup> class or equivalent for admission in B.Tech. Programs of the Institute under DASA, SII, MEA, Indian Council for Cultural Relation (ICCR) scheme of MoE, Govt. of India.

The undersigned is directed to refer to D.O. communication No.Q/Wel/855/2/2021 dated 10<sup>th</sup> May, 2021 received from the Ministry of External Affairs vide which the Ministry of Education was requested to consider waiving the criteria of Joint Entrance Examination (Main) and allow to continue with the earlier criteria of SAT-II scores for admissions in respect of the children of Indian Government officials posted abroad in the ensuing academic year 2021-2022 against the 79 supernumerary seats allocated to the MEA.

However, from the academic year 2022-2023, admissions to 79 supernumerary seats (as communicated vide this Ministry's letter F.No.19-1/2019-TC dated 25<sup>th</sup> May, 2021) shall be based on the ranks secured by the aspiring students in the Joint Entrance Examination (Main) conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA). It is requested that necessary change(s) in the admission criteria for academic year 2022-2023 may suitably be notified / given wider publicity for the aforesaid quota.
