In the 4th meeting of Building & Works Committee held on 13.12.2005. the BWC approved the RCE amounting to RS.120.10 Lacs for the provision of size 25mX15m Swimming Pool at NIT, Kurukshetra as agenda item No. 4.12. But as per the requirement of the Olympic size 50mX25m by the Sports Department including seating arrangements for the Spectators that NBCC submitted a RRCE for Rs.240.76 Lacs. However, the BWC approved this estimate in its meeting held on 24.04.2006 at agenda item No. 6.16, the same has been confirmed by the BWC in the 7th meeting of BWC held on 18,10.2006. The work was not carried out by NBCC. The Institute decided to disengage NBCC w.e.f. 31.03.2007.

After a lot of meetings and discussions at various levels by the committee, it was decided on 18.04.2007 and approved by the Director to engage C.P.W.D for this job (File CC/3417 NP-4 to 6). Accordingly, the C.P.W.D was intimated wide this office Letter No.EO/3498 dated 04.05.2007 & 3493 dated 01.04.2008 and 7304-08 dated 10.07.2008 to under take the construction works of Swimming Pool at an estimated cost of Rs.240.76 Lacs. In response to our Letter No.CC/7304-08 dated 10.07.2008, the chief Engineer (NZ-I), CPWD Chandigarh sent us an estimate for the construction of Swimming Pool amounting to Rs.3,96,75,800/-Including Civil, Public Health an Electricals works vide his office Letter No.23(390)Se(P)/EE(PII)1657 dated 31.07.2008, but the CPWD did not take up the work and thus this Institute decided to withdraw this work from CPWD vide this office Letter No.CC/0117 dated 29.10.2008 provided no financial implication is involved. In this regard, a meeting with Sh. D.S Sangwan, XEN, CPWD was held On 23.12.2008, who assured to start the work within 3 months after the receipt of administrative approval. The worthy Director has agreed to reengage the CPWD for the construction of Swimming Pool at NIT, Kurukshetra at N.P-I. Now the matter is pending with this office for the grant of administrative approval amounting to Rs.3,96,75,800/- and to reengage CPWD for this job.

NIT, KURUKSEHTRA FOR EXECUTION OF WORKS

This Memorandum of Understanding, hereinafter called MoU signed between the Central Public Works Department, hereinafter called the CPWD represented by the Executive Engineer, Karnal Central Division, CPWD, 448, Subhash Colony, Karnal on the one part and NIT, Kurukshetra (the name of the client department) herein after called the client (represented by Registrar, NIT, Kurukshetra) on the other on this day, the 20th of November, 2012 at NIT, Kurukshetra.

Whereas the CPWD have agreed to undertake the execution of the works hereafter on the basis of designs and drawings prepared by CPWD and approved by the client as a deposit work, now therefore it is agreed between the two parties that:-

1. The CPWD shall execute the work on the basis of Architectural drawings prepared by CPWD and approved by the client.

2. The Preliminary Estimate, based on the preliminary drawings & designs shall be submitted by CPWD and approved by the client with issue of A/A & E/S.

3. Based on the Approved Architectural drawings, CPWD will prepare working drawings, specifications & scope of work for detailed estimate for approval of the authority competent to technically sanction the detailed estimate.

4. The Client shall deposit funds in installments. In the first instance, 33% of the sanctioned amount shall be deposited by the Client with the Executive Engineer, Karnal Central Division, CPWD, Karnal along with sanction as advance in two installments as under:

a) First installment of 16.5% shall be deposited by the client immediately after the accord of A/A & E/S of the work, thereafter tender shall be invited by the CPWD.

Next installment of 16.5% shall be deposited immediately after receipt of tenders by CPWD and thereafter the tender shall be accepted by CPWD. Thereafter the expenditure incurred shall be reimbursed in full through regular bills. The deposit with CPWD shall not fall below 10% of the estimated cost at any point of time during execution of the work. This portion of deposits shall be retained for adjustment against the last portion of the estimated expenditure.

- c) No Interest will be paid by CPWD to the client department on the deposit received for execution of the work.
- d) CPWD will ensure that the defects liability amount (security deposit) be released to the executing agency only after removal of all defects/shortcomings brought to the notice by the client during the defect liability period.
- A progress review committee consisting of S.E.(C), S.E.(E), E.E.(C) & E.E.(E) from CPWD and Dean (P&O), Dean (Estate) and other concerned officials of the Estate Section of NIT Kurukshetra shall meet monthly to review the progress of works allotted to CPWD and to resolve any outstanding issues.

The Board of Governors of the Institute in their 15th meeting held on 18.05.2009 has decided as under:-

"The Board ratified the minutes of 15th meeting of the Finance Committee of the Institute held on 21.2.2009.

While discussing the Revised Budget Estimates for the year 2008-09 and the Original Budget Estimates for the year 2009-10 (Non-Plan) as contained in the budget, the Board noted that a part provision for the revised pay scales of the staff members was included in the Budget Estimates and the same will be reviewed at the time of preparing the Revised Budget Estimates for the year 2009-10.

The Board also made the following observations on some of the recommendations made by the Finance Committee:-

- i) Regarding opening an account with the HDFC Bank for foreign exchange purposes (FC agenda item 15.9), the Board desired that preference should be given to the branches of SBI at Kurukshetra.
 - It was also advised that matter be taken up with the higher authorities of the SBI to introduce such facilities at Kurukshetra.
- ii) Regarding FC items 15.12, 15.13 and 15.14 the Board advised that the matter should be referred to the MHRD for proper instructions in the matter.
- iii) Regarding FC agenda item 15.18, the Board desired that 40% of the arrears due to implementation of 6th Pay Commission Report may be released to ex employees of the Institute who retired after 1.1.2006 after taking proper legal undertaking from them. In case any recovery is required to

be made, the same may be adjusted against 60% arrears to be paid later on as per instructions of the MHRD.

iv) Regarding FC agenda item 15.25, the Board constituted a committee consisting of Sh. Madan Mohan, Director(NITs), MHRD, New Delhi, Sh. S. Mohan, Director (Finance), IFD, MHRD, New Delhi and Mrs. (Dr.) Sudesh Mukhopadhyay to examine the matter regarding promotion of the non teaching staff as mentioned in the agenda item. The committee will be assisted by the Registrar/Deputy Registrar(Estt.) of the Institute. The committee will meet at New Delhi in the next week preferably on 25th or 26th May, 2009. The committee will submit its report within a fortnight to the Hon'ble Chairperson, BΦG for final decision.

Regarding FC Agenda item 15.26, the Board decided that the consolidated salary being paid by the Institute to the Senior Medical Officer plus pension drawn by him from the State Govt. should not exceed last emoluments drawn by him at the time of his retirement from the services of the State Govt.

The Board desired that a proposal regarding enhancement of hostel charges from the students residing in new hostels which are having better physical conditions/facilities may be placed before the Finance Committee in its next meeting.

The Board further desired that the Ministry of Social Justice/Tribal Development may be approached for availing the facility of scholarship schemes for SC/ST students etc."

Further, you are hereby intimated that the Institute had made the final payment to CPWD as per final utilization certificates and the work had already been closed in the year 2017. So, the above matter regarding claim of agency through arbitrator is between the CPWD and the agency.

Therefore, it is requested not to make any payment towards arbitration fees from the funds available of NIT with the CPWD without prior permission of the competent authority of the Institute.

This may be treated as most urgent.

NIT, KURUKSEHTRA FOR EXECUTION OF WORKS

This Memorandum of Understanding, hereinafter called MoU signed between the Central Public Works Department, hereinafter called the CPWD represented by the Executive Engineer, Karnal Central Division, CPWD, 448, Subhash Colony, Karnal on the one part and NIT, Kurukshetra (the name of the client department) herein after called the client (represented by Registrar, NIT, Kurukshetra) on the other on this day, the 20th of November, 2012 at NIT, Kurukshetra.

Whereas the CPWD have agreed to undertake the execution of the works hereafter on the basis of designs and drawings prepared by CPWD and approved by the client as a deposit work, now therefore it is agreed between the two parties that:-

1. The CPWD shall execute the work on the basis of Architectural drawings prepared by CPWD and approved by the client.

2. The Preliminary Estimate, based on the preliminary drawings & designs shall be submitted by CPWD and approved by the client with issue of A/A & E/S.

3. Based on the Approved Architectural drawings, CPWD will prepare working drawings, specifications & scope of work for detailed estimate for approvallof the authority competent to technically sanction the detailed estimate.

4. The Client shall deposit funds in installments. In the first instance, 33% of the sanctioned amount shall be deposited by the Client with the Executive Engineer, Karnal Central Division, CPWD, Karnal along with sanction as advance in two installments as under:

a) First installment of 16.5% shall be deposited by the client immediately after the accord of A/A & E/S of the work, thereafter tender shall be invited by the CPWD.

Next installment of 16.5% shall be deposited immediately after receipt of tenders by CPWD and thereafter the tender shall be accepted by CPWD. Thereafter the expenditure incurred shall be reimbursed in Iull through regular bills. The deposit with CPWD shall not fall below 10% of the estimated cost at any point of time during execution of the work. This portion of deposits shall be retained for adjustment against the last portion of the estimated expenditure.

- c) No Interest will be paid by CPWD to the client department on the deposit received for execution of the work.
- d) CPWD will ensure that the defects liability amount (security deposit) be released to the executing agency only after removal of all defects/ shortcomings brought to the notice by the client during the defect liability period.
- 5. A progress review committee consisting of S.E.(C), S.E.(E), E.E.(C) & E.E.(E) from CPWD and Dean (P&D), Dean (Estate) and other concerned officials of the Estate Section of NIT Kurukshetra shall meet monthly to review the progress of works allotted to CPWD and to resolve any outstanding issues.

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

- 7.8 Intimating the Client about any excess over the projected cost timely or possibility of time overrun on every mile stone with reasons.
- Intimating the physical and financial progress every month. 7.9
- 7.10 Replying to the audit objections pertaining to the work in so far as they pertain to its acts in execution of the work.
- Handing over to Client the completed buildings along with a set of 7.11 completion drawings, as built sketch & inventory.
- Intimating the final cost of the project. 7.12
- Contesting the claims of the contractors in arbitration or appearing in 7.13 other legal matters pertaining to executing of work. That it shall be the responsibility of CPWD to maintain accounts of the works, defend effectively arbitration and court cases arising out of the work contracts. Funds for making payment of all amounts which may be decreed by Court of Law, Tribunal or by award of an Arbitrator in relation to the deposit work will be made available to CPWD by the client department within 15 days from the date of receipt of such demand as aforesaid from CPWD. Such payments will be in addition to the payments made to the contractors for execution of work.
- Replying any type of query raised through RTI and by CVC/CTE. 7.14
- So far as quality of work is concerned, the prescribed quality control 7.15 tests as per CPWD specifications shall be conducted.
- Crediting to NIT Kurukshetra the forfeited carnest money, performance 7.16 guarantee, any compensation imposed on the executing agency as per relevant provisions of the contract agreement. ,

The Client agrees to undertake the following: 8.

- Deposit the required funds as per schedule specified above. Deposit 8.1 any additional funds that may be required to complete the work as per revised estimate submitted by the CPWD.
- According approval to architectural drawings and preliminary estimate 8.2



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submitted by CPWD.

8.3 Making available the site of work free from encumbrances.

Enhancing the cost and time stipulated in the Preliminary Estimate if changes are made in the approved Design/ Architectural Drawings & Specifications as well as if the site of work is altered and/or if the site is handed over to CPWD with delay.

Obtaining necessary clearances for the Architectural/Structural plans from the concerned statutory bodies.

8.6 Helping the CPWD in obtaining necessary service connections.

Providing the required funds as per cash flow requirements projected by the CPWD.

8.8 According revised sanction without any delay in case of cost escalation.

Providing security clearances for **CPWD** staff/contractors and their workers in case it is so required.

Designating a suitably empowered nodal officer for coordinating with the CPWD for the entire project duration. All communications by the designated officer will be made with the designated officer of CPWD. The designated nodal officer shall be authorized to take decisions and assist the CPWD in completion of project. The nodal officer shall also be empowered to take decisions on remedial measures for unforescen situations arising out of entities external to the project.

8.11 Providing full assistance to the CPWD in the execution of the work.

- 9. That CPWD shall engage specialized consultants for providing Comprehensive Architectural, Structural, MEP, EIA, Sewerage, Water Supply, GRIHA, Environment ctc. services, wherever required. The CPWD shall be authorized to book expenditure involved in engaging such consultants on the project under the head enabling works. For pre-tendering activities such as soil testing, survey etc., if required, enabling estimates shall be sanctioned by the client.
- 10. That on physical completion of work, CPWD shall notify the client, details of inventory, completion reports & drawings. On receipt of such notification, the client shall take over the work that has been completed satisfactorily within 15 days. For this purpose, all documents required in the form of services operation/maintenance scheme plans etc. will be finalized/prepared by CPWD and passed on to the client.
- 11. That any amendment/ alteration/ additional scope of work etc. and also modification in terms & conditions of MoU shall be made by mutual consent of both the parties of this MoU.
- 12. That force majeure clause shall be applicable, where one party shall not be liable, as per MoU, to other for any loss or damage occasioned by or arising out of act of God, or inevitable events such as floods, volcanic eruptions, earthquake, or other convulsion of nature and other act beyond the control of both the parties.
- 13. That in case the work is foreclosed by the client, for any reason whatsoever it may be, CPWD shall foreclose the contract and pay final bill to the contractor/consultant etc. as per contract conditions, payment of which shall be immediately released by the client.

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Dispute Resolution Mechanism:

- In case the review committee is not able to ensure implementation of the agreed provisions of the MoU, Director, NIT Kurukshetra & Chief Engineer (NZ-I), CPWD, Kendriya Sadan, Sec-9 A, Chandigarh shall meet & mutually decide on the issues involved.
- 14.2 If any dispute/difference arising between the parties as mentioned above is not resolved the matter shall be referred to Board of Governors of NIT, Kurukshetra and Additional Director General, NR-II, CPWD, Chandigarh.
- 14.3 Any dispute which still remains unresolved, the same shall be dealt as per Government of India norms prevailing at that time.

Executive Engineer Karnal Central Division CPWD, Karnal Registrar (zd12/17) NIT, Kurukshetra. Subject: -Construction of Swimming Pool at NIT, Kurukshetra.

The above cited work of Construction of Swimming Pool of size 25m x 15m at NIT, Kurukshetra was approved by B&WC in its 4th meeting held on 13.12.2005 vide item no. 4.12 for an amount of Rs. 120.10 lacs. Further, NBCC submitted a Revised Cost Estimate for an amount of Rs. 240.76 as per requirement of Sports Section including seating arrangement for the Spectators and the same was approved by B&WC in its 6th meeting held on 24.04.2006 vide item no. 6.16 and confirmed by the B&WC in its 7th meeting held on 18.10.2006, Subsequently approved by FC in its 9th meeting held on 28.10.2006 and BOG in its 12th 25.04.2007. However, the work was not carried out by NBCC. Since Institute decided to disengage NBCC w.e.f. 31.03.2007.

After several meetings and discussions at various levels at the institute, it was decided on 18.04.2007 after duly approved by the Director to engage PIGG CPWD for the work of Swimming Pool. Accordingly, CPWD was intimated vide the office letter no. EO/3498 dated 04.05.2007 & 3493 dated 01.04.2008 and 7304-08 dated 10.07.2008 to undertake the construction work of Swimming Pool at an estimated cost of Rs. 240.76 lacs. In response to our letter No. CC/7304-08 dated 10.07.2008, the Chief Engineer (NZ-I), CPWD, Chandigarn sent an estimate for the above said work for an amount of Rs. 3,96,75,800/- including Civil, Public Health and Electricals works vide letter no.23(390)SE(P)/EE(PH)/1657 dated 31.07.2008, but the CPWD did not take up the work and thus this Institute decided to withdraw this work from CPWD vide the office letter no. CC/0117 dated 29.10.2008 provided no financial implication is involved. On the withdrawal of the work form CPWD, CPWD demanded a sum of Rs. 1,98,379/- from NIT, Kurukshetra on a/c of charges for the preparation of estimate and drawings vide letter no. 54(466)/KCD/2008/5103 dated 27.11.2008.

In this regard, a meeting with Sh. D.S. Sangwan, Executive Engineer (CPWD) was held on 23.12.2008, who assured to start the work within 3 months after the receipt of administrative approval. The Hon'ble Director agreed to reengage CPWD for the construction of Swimming Pool. Accordingly, approval was taken the Director and Chairman of B&WC. After that the execution of work was communicated to CPWD, Karnal office Vide the office letter no. 458 dated 15.01.2009 (copy enclosed). As per CPWD process, the work was allotted to the executing agency for execution of work vide letter no. 54(496)/KCD/2348 dated 18.01.2009 (copy enclosed). It was expected that as per MOU guidelines the work will be carried out by CPWD. The MOU between CPWD and Institute states that the CPWD will undertake the execution of the works after the design and drawings prepared by CPWD approved by the client.

Whereas the CPWD have agreed to undertake the execution of the works hereafter on the basis of designs and drawings prepared by CPWD and approved by the client as a deposit work, now therefore it is agreed between the two parties that: -

The CPWD shall execute the work on the basis of Architectural drawings prepared by CPWD and approved by the client.

The Preliminary Estimate, based on the preliminary drawings & designs shall be submitted by CPWD and approved by the client with issue of A/A & E/S.

Based on the Approved Architectural drawings, CPWD will prepage working drawings, specifications & scope of work for detailed estimate for approval of the authority competent to technically sanction the detailed estimate.

It is relevant to mention that the working drawings, specifications & scope of work for detailed estimate prepared by the CPWD were not sanctioned by the authority of the institute and nor involved in the sanctioning process. The agreement between the CPWD and the executing party has not been discussed with the institute at any level.

Later on cost estimate received from CPWD for an amount of Rs. 3,96,75,800/- was approved by the B&WC in its 10th meeting held on 19.02.2009 vide item no. 10.4 without having any detailed specification of the items. Subsequently approved by FC in its 15th meeting held on 21.02.2009 and BOG in its 15th 18.05.2009. During the execution of the work, several times the CPWD was intimated regarding the slow progress of the work (copy enclosed).

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The Executive Engineer (Civil), CPWD intimated vide letter no. 54(NIT)/KCD/2012/278 dated 05.02.2013 that the work has been completed and testing work is in progress and also requested the Institute to conduct the Inspection of work for taking over the Swimming Pool. The Inspection Committee duly constituted by the competent authority of the institute was intimated vide letter no. CC/60 dated 22.02.2013 to conduct the inspection of the said work. Accordingly, inspection of the work was conducted on dated 28:02:2013 by the Inspection Committee (copy enclosed). The shortcomings/observations made by the Inspection 1932 Committee were conveyed to the CPWD for rectification vide letter no. CC/98/2035 dated 28.03.2013 (copy enclosed). The compliance of the shortcomings/observations pointed out by the Inspection Committee was made by the CPWD as stated in letter No. 54(NIT)/PS/KCD/2013/ dated 20.12.2013 (copy enclosed).

Accordingly, the Inspection Committee inspected the work again on 03.01.2014. During the Inspection it was found that the observations pointed out in the previous inspection visit have been attended by the CPWD. The final Inspection report of the Inspection Committee was submitted and the copy enclosed. The committee had also observed that the work of Swimming Pool building is complete and it can be taken over by the Institute.

Further, the Executive Engineer (Civil), CPWD submitted the inventory, 19 37 42 architectural/structural drawings vide letter no. 20(NIT)/KCD/2014/248 dated 22.01.2014. Accordingly, the swimming pool was handed over to Presidents Sports (Boys & Girls) vide letter no. CC/3169/25 dated 23.01.2014 (copy enclosed). After 19/93 that CPWD submitted the copy of final bill & final utilization certificate of Rs. 3,98,04,808/- vide letters no. 54(NIT)/KCD/4030 dated 04.10.2016 & 45-4 64(NIT)/KCD/2016/6038 dated 28.12.2016.

In this regard, the final payment of Rs. 7,28,808/- has been released on dated 10.03.2017 as per final utilization certificate (copy enclosed).

Now, a letter has been received from Executive Engineer (Civil), CPWD vide no. 54(NIT)/CD/2021/987 dated 29.05.2021 regarding matter of arbitration between M/s. Chiranji Lal Gupta & Sons (P) Ltd. & the CPWD Union of India for the work Construction of Swimming Pool. It is stated that the agency of the above work has gone into arbitration for settlement of certain disputes which have arisen in the above mentioned work and accordingly, an Arbitrator has been appointed by the competent authority of CPWD (copy enclosed). The payment of arbitration fees will be made from the funds of NIT available with the department. The total amount claimed by the agency is Rs. 2,39,04,538/-.

In the reply of the above letter, the Institute sent a letter to Executive Engineer (Civil), CPWD vide no. CC/3169/304/1940 dated 15.06.2021, requesting not to make any payment towards arbitration fees from the funds of NIT available with CPWD without prior permission of the Competent Authority of the Institute. In response to above, the Executive Engineer (Civil) CPWD intimated vide letter no. 54(NIT)CD/2021/1121 dated 17.06.2021 mentioning Clause 7.13 of MoU between CPWD & NIT Kurukshetra as reproduced below:

"Funds for making payment of all amounts which may be decreed by Court of Law, tribunal or by award of an Arbitrator in relation to the deposit work will be made available to CPWD by the client department within 15 days from the date of receipt of such demand as aforesaid from CPWD. Such payments will be in addition to the payments made to the contractors for execution of work."

The Executive Engineer (Civil), CPWD also requested to look into the matter and to grant permission to the office for making the payment of arbitration fees from the funds of the NIT as per the MoU conditions stated above. Further, it is also mentioned in the letter that out of the total arbitration fees 50% of the fees is to be paid by the claimant i.e. the agency and rest 50% by the respondent i.e. CPWD from the funds of the client department i.e. NIT.

Further, it is apprised that the work has already been completed and handed over about 7 years back to Presidents Sports (Boys & Girls) of the Institute. Also the final payment had been released as per final Bill/UC about 4 years back and the facility is under use by the Institute. The issue of arbitration has been raised by the contractor/agency requesting to CPWD to appoint an Arbitrator in this case.

Hence, in the light of the above facts, the legal opinion of the Legal Counsel of the Institute may kindly obtained regarding the matter of arbitration between M/s. Chiranji Lal Gupta & Sons (P) Ltd. 2nd Union of India for the work of Construction of Swimming Pool at NIT Kurukshetra before taking any decision.

LEGAL OPINION

I have gone through the notings, as well as the other accompanying documents. From the perusal of the same it is revealed that the Institute allotted the work of construction of Swimming Pool at NITK to CPWD, Karnal Central Division on the same terms and conditions of the MOU dated 25.10.2007 entered into between the parties in respect of earlier allotted two works. After completion of work and removal of deficiencies as reported in earlier inspections, the CPWD submitted Final bill vide its letter dated 04.10.2016. Thereafter CPWD also submitted Final Utilization certificate vide its letter dated 28.12.2016. The record further revealed that the CPWD vide its letter dated 29.05.2021 has intimated the Institute that the contractor has gone in the Arbitration for settlement of certain disputes and that the Arbitrator has been appointed and further that the Arbitration fees will be made from the funds available of NIT with the department, it also revealed that the claim of the agency is of Rs. 2,39,04,538/-. Further it is revealed from the record that the Institute vide its reply/letter dated 15.06.2021 disputed the same and instructed the CPWD not to make any payment towards arbitration fees from the funds available of NITK with the department without prior permission of the competent authority of NITK. Further vide their letter dated 17.06.2021 CPWD requested the Institute to grant permission for making payment of arbitration fees from the funds of NITK as per the conditions of MOU by refering para 7.13 of the same. From the notings as well as the documents as referred to as above it is revealed that Para 7.13 of MOU entered into between the parties provides as under:

"Funds for making payment of all amounts which may be decreed by Court of Law, Tribunal or by award of an Arbitrator in relation to the deposit work will be made available to CPWD by the client department within 15 days from the date of receipt of such demand as aforesaid from CPWD, such payments will be in addition to the payments made to the contractors for execution of

work."

As per the terms and condition as refered above at best the NITK may be liable to pay the decreed amount as per the award, if any, to be made by the Arbitrator, but that eventuality has not yet arisen as the Arbitartor has yet to proceed with the arbitration and during arbitration proceedings it is the bounden duty of the CPWD to defend the same, as admittedly the claim of the Contractor is a stale claim barred by limitaion which is also clear from the letter dated 21.05.2021 appointing Arbitrator.

In my considered opinion, the CPWD can't require the NITK to pay any amount towards arbitration proceedings nor the CPWD can deduct any amount from the funds of NITK lying with the CPWD, towards fees of Arbitrator to be paid in advance as the sole responsibility of pursuing the arbitration proceedings is of CPWD, at best the CPWD can raise demand from NITK only after, if any award is passed by the Arbitrator but before that the CPWD can't require the NITK to pay any amount towards Arbitration proceedings nor deduct any such amount towards fees to be paid to Arbitrator from the funds of NITK lying with the CPWD.

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BWC 27.13 To report for rectification of action taken by Director and Chairman B&WC of the Institute in anticipation of the approval of the Building and Works Committee on exclusion of "providing GPRS based energy monitoring and billing system" within the work of "Provision & Installation of Electrical Sub-Station HT/LT Distribution and feeder pillars in residential area at NIT Kurukshetra".

The work of Installation of HT/LT Distribution and feeder pillars in residential area at NIT Kurukshetra was approved in 9th & 11th B&WC meetings held on 17.03.2008 & 28.07.2009 respectively and duly ratified by the 20th BOG meeting held on 15.03.2010. Accordingly, the work was allotted to CPWD for execution vide letter No. CC/156/7071 dated 18.11.2014 on depositary work basis. The CPWD awarded the work to contractor M/s. Kalsi Engineers, New Delhi vide letter no. 54(4)/KCED/2015-16/82 dated 14.01.2016 as enclosed in **Appendix XXXX from page 570 to 596.**

lt is also apprised that during the execution, a dispute was generated between CPWD & Contractor M/s. Kalsi Engineers, New Delhi as informed vide letter no. 24/01/2018A&C/6230 dated 01.01.2018 by Chief Engineer (NZ-I), CPWD, Chandigarh. In this letter, it was stated that matter is under arbitration (copy enclosed). Further, Executive Engineer (Elect.), Karnal Electrical Division, CPWD, Karnal had intimated vide letter no. 54(Arb)/KED/2020-21/1030 dated 31.07.2020 that the Arbitrator has awarded a sum of Rs. 1,08,85,003.03/- in favour of contractor M/s. Kalsi Engineers, New Delhi including interest @ 10% w.e.f. 01.01.2018 to till date of disbursement of the amount to the contractor. After submission of the arbitration award by the CPWD, the institute referred the whole matter to the legal counsel of the institute for legal opinion. In the mean time, a letter no. 54(Arb)/KED/2020-21/1409 dated 05.11.2020 was received from Executive Engineer (Elect.), Karnal Electrical Division, CPWD, Karnal regarding revised amount of Rs 1,04,62,508/- for the arbitration award as enclosed in Appendix XXXXI from page 597 to 602.

As per the legal opinion of legal counsel of the Institute, the amount towards the claim no. 3, 4, 11 and 12 has been deducted and the balance amount of Rs 66,29,173/- has been released by the Institute after approval by the competent authority of Institute as enclosed in **Appendix XXXXII from page 603 to 606**.

It is further informed that GPRS based energy monitoring and billing system (being part of the above said work) has not been executed by CPWD till date. In this regard a letter No./CC/3454/485 dated 02/11/2020 has been sent to Executive Engineer (Elect.), Karnal Electrical Division, CPWD, Karnal to provide the estimation —562—

for the remaining work. The preliminary estimate amounting Rs 46,85,730/- for the remaining work has been received from Executive Engineer (Elect.), Karnal Electrical Division, CPWD, Karnal vide letter no.20(7)/KED/2021/586/3488 dated 23/04/2021. However, the total expenditure including the arbitration award amounting Rs 2,77,33,063.03/- is already on the higher side from the A/A & E/S of Rs. 2,22,69,434.00 already conveyed to CPWD. Now, it is informed that the balance work of GPRS based energy monitoring and billing system can be executed as per preliminary estimate as submitted by CPWD either by making additional expenditure in the same work or by conveying a fresh AA & ES for the balance work as per institute rules as enclosed in **Appendix XXXXIII from page 607 to 613.**

It is pertinent to mention here that currently the HT/LT Distribution system and feeder pillars in residential area is in operation by manual mode and performance is found to be satisfactory. Further, old staff/faculty residential quarters in the campus are proposed to be demolished in future which is in planning stage as per the Master plan of the Institute. On basis of satisfactory performance of existing HT/LT Distribution and feeder pillars in residential area and in light of future master plan of the Institute, it is proposed that the provision of GPRS based energy monitoring and billing system may be dispensed with in the existing HT/LT infrastructure.

In view of above, competent authority of the Institute has given approval to dispense with the work of providing GPRS based energy monitoring and billing system in the work of "Installation of HT/LT Distribution and feeder pillars in residential area at NIT Kurukshetra" and the same has been conveyed to the Executive Engineer (Elect.), CPWD, Karnal vide letter no. CC/3453/338/2187 dated 07.07.2021 as enclosed in **Appendix XXXXIV from page 614 to 616.**

The Building & Works Committee may consider and ratify the decision taken by Chairman Building & Works Committee to dispensed with the work of providing GPRS based energy monitoring and billing system from the work of "Installation of HT/LT Distribution and feeder pillars in residential area at NIT Kurukshetra" at NIT Kurukshetra.

After the detailed discussion by NIT, Kurukshetra & CPWD with the consultant, the consultant submitted the revised rough cost estimate amounting to Rs. 582.00 lacs (approx.) covering the entire campus including residential sector as suggested by BWC. The revised cost estimated for the entire work is enclosed.

In view of the position explained above, it is proposed that the BWC may consider and approve the RCE amounting to Rs. 582.00 lacs (approx.) for the installation of HT/LT Sub- Station in the Institute.

The Board was assured that its advice shall be invariably followed and required procedure as laid down under the Statutes shall be adhered to.

The representatives of Govt. of India, MHRD, Sh. N. Mohan Das expressed serious concern on the procedural lapses in not placing and obtaining approval of minutes of the Building & Works Committee meeting of 28th July, 2009 and 3rd September, 2009 from the competent authority. - a. Before the start of the meeting the Hon'ble Chairman BOG and Mr. K.N. Ral, Former Chief Executive & Advisor Ministry of Defense (DRDO) inspected vulnerable spots of the campus along the boundary wall and also visited residence of Prof. S.S. Rattan along with the Dean (Estate).
- b. The report of the committee appointed by the Director for the enquiry on the incidence of attack on the Professor of the Institute was discussed and reviewed that various inputs given by the committee for improvement of security system.
- c. The report of security officer was also studied.

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Taking into account all the issues and deliberations on security, the following recommendations are made:

Height and size of perimeter wall: It was resolved that the height of boundary wall all along the periphery be 7 ft above the ground level and Concertina coil of approximately 40 cm, diameter be placed over the wall all around. The cost estimate of this work be discussed in Building Works Committee meeting and placed for approval in the ensuing BOG meeting.

Peripheral area should be cleared all along the boundary wall so that security personnel can move around to check any illegal entry from the wall.

2. Main Entry and Exit Points: The entry & exit points of the institute be limited to 2 or 3:

3. Security Checks at Gates: The above mentioned gates should have proper security posts to check the entry & exit of persons or vehicles.

4. Manpower and Vehicle Check: The registration numbers of all the vehicles along with the time of entering into the campus and leaving the campus must be recorded.

5. System of Identity Cards & Vehicle Stickers: All Institute employees, employees engaged through outsourcing, all shopkeepers inside the premises should have identity cards which should be displayed their person.

6. CCTV Surveillance and Recording System: All the Gates through which entry & exit is taking place must have CCTV surveillance camera whose data should be stored in the

recording/control room of security.

7. Identification of Servants

7. Identification of Servants and Casual Workers: There should be polloe verification of all the domestic servants, street hawkers, news-paper vendors, etc. All casual workers engaged by CPWD must stay in a segregated place in the campus and CPWD should issue tokens to contractors/ workers for entering and exiting from the campus.

8. Security Guards at Checking Points and Night Patrolling: Apart from security guards at sensitive locations there should be patrolling of the entire campus by security vehicle(s). There should be more patrolling during the day time in the residential and hostel area.

9. Arrangement with Local Police: The Institute authorities must have proper liaison with the nearest police station and the contact details of SHO of the area must be displayed prominently for the people to contact in the hour of needs.

Verification of Security Agency and their Employees: 10. Since the security services to the Institute are being undertaken by an agency recognized by DGR and PSARA and all are exserviceman. Hence, it is satisfactory. Their number may be augmented.

Regulation/ Record of Students Movement out of 11. Campus: It was suggested that students entry & exit from the

campus should be monitored through swipe card.

Regular Security Drills and General Awareness of Residents: It was observed that there are requirements of regular security drills by the security personnels and making residents aware about general security related issues.

Street and Area Lighting: It was observed that the illumination level in the Institutional and Flostel area is satisfactory, however, the residential area illumination level is less, it was resolved that there is a need of extending build supply in the residential area locadoressants is she

Surprise Check on Residents: There should be surprise checks on the occupants of the houses to ensure that there is no

subletting and any illegal person is staying.

A protocol will be prepared for taking any emergent action needed in the residential area. This will included identifying two faculty members (on rotation basis for every month) to be incharge for the residential area for any one to get necessary help.

16. A detailed security manual will be prepared for implementation.

In addition to the above following points were identified for action.

Illegal Huts of Ex-employees within the premises of NIT Kurukshetra be removed.

b. One or two faculty members of the Institute be given the responsibility of Estate Manager so that they can be contacted for any emergency needs.

c. The PWD complex within the NIT Campus may be moved out as they are not being assigned any work of NIT. In the mean

time their portion may be segregated by a wall. ,

d. If possible a space for security be earmarked in which temporary structures may be made for stay of about 30 security personnels with the provision of cooking and toilet. This will be helpful in meeting the requirement of security personnels in exigency by the institute.

It is resolved all the above recommendations and actions will be placed before the next BOG meeting in September, 2014.

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actual work done as per the arbitration award is equals to Rs 2,44,50,121.03 /-which is on higher side in comparison to the A/A & E/S of Rs. 2,22,69,434.00 already conveyed to the CPWD. Further, after including the additional amount of arbitration Rs 15,04,196.00 /- and the interest amount of Rs. 17,78,746 /- for arbitration, the total expenditure becomes equal to Rs 2,77,33,063.03/-.

It is further informed that GPRS based energy monitoring and billing system (being part of the above said work) has not been executed by CPWD till date. In this regard a letter No./CC/3454/485 dated 02/11/2020 has been sent to Executive Engineer (Elect.), Karnal, Electrical Division, CPWD, Karnal to provide the estimation for the remaining work. The preliminary estimate amounting Rs 46,85,730/- for the remaining work has been received from Executive Engineer (Elect.), Karnal Electrical Division, CPWD, Karnal vide letter, no.20(7)/KED/2021/586 dated 23/04/2021. However, the total expenditure including the arbitration award amounting Rs 2,77,33,063.03/- is already on the higher side from the A/A & E/S of Rs. 2,22,69,434.00 already conveyed to CPWD. Now, it is informed that the balance work of GPRS based energy monitoring and billing system can be executed as per preliminary estimate as submitted by CPWD either by making additional expenditure in the same work or by conveying a fresh AA & ES for the balance work as per institute rules.

It is pertinent to mention here that currently the HT/LT Distribution system and feeder pillars in residential area is in operation by manual mode and performance is found to be satisfactory. Further, old staff/faculty residential quarters in the campus are proposed to be demolished in future which is in planning stage as per the Master plan of the Institute. On basis of satisfactory performance of existing HT/LT Distribution and feeder pillars in residential area and in light of future master plan of the Institute, it is proposed that the provision of GPRS based energy monitoring and billing system may be dispensed with in the existing HT/LT infrastructure.

In view of above, if agreed, the Hon'ble Director & Chairman (B&WC) may accord necessary approval to dispense with the work of providing GPRS based energy monitoring and billing system in the work of "Installation of HT/LT Distribution and feeder pillars in residential area at NIT Kurukshetra" in anticipation of the approval of B & WC and the matter may be placed before ensuing B&WC for report & ratification. The approval may also be accorded to obtain the final bill from the CPWD for the above said work, so that the work may be capitalized at the earliest.
