This is in partial modification of letter No. Acad./2023/1232 dated 07.08.2023 regarding the relaxation in the academic rules approved by the Senate in its 50th meeting held on 25.07.2023 vide agenda item No. S 50.05 for promotion to higher semester of B.Tech. Programme. The Competent Authority in capacity of Chairman, Senate has approved the following changes in the scheme for conducting reappear examinations:

- a) The guidelines as at point (i) remain same and will be effective from A.Y. 2023-24 for all batches.
- b) The guidelines as at point (ii) will be effective for the newly admitted B.Tech. batches from A.Y. 2023-24 onwards including those students who are allowed to continue their study along with B.Tech. batches from A.Y. 2023-24 onwards in 1st and/or 2nd Semester onwards. However, for the B.Tech. batches prior to A.Y. 2023-24, the existing scheme of conducting reappear examinations will continue.

Therefore, the students of B.Tech. Programme, other than mentioned at Point No. (b) above, will be allowed to appear for reappear examination of courses offered in Even Semester in Odd Semester and vice versa.

The Senate in its 50th meeting held on 25.07.2023 vide agenda item no. S 50.05 approved relaxation in the academic rules for promotion to higher semester of B.Tech. programme with the following guidelines which will be effective from academic session 2023-24 for all batches.:

- A student will be promoted to the higher semester irrespective of number of (i) reappears in lower semesters. However, student will not be allowed to appear in the examinations for more than N+6 courses in any semester, where 'N' is the total no. of courses of the current semester the student is studying in and 6 is the maximum number of reappear courses (internal and/or external).
- The examination of odd semester courses (both internal and external) will be (ii) held in odd semester and the examination of even semester courses (both internal and external) will be held in even semester.
