The Institute campus is about 10 kms from Pipli, a well known road junction on the Sher Shah Suri Marg

Kurukshetra is a railway junction on the Delhi-Karnal-Ambala section of the Northern Railway. It is about 160 kms from Delhi and about 5km from Kurukshetra Railway station.

Distance between Delhi to Kurukshetra by Road is 167 kms and time taken is 2.50 hours.
