PAPER SUBMISSION PROCEDURE/PORTAL:

The following process needs to be followed for the submission of the paper.

1. Please check the format of your paper as per the conference guidelines and ensure it is plagiarism-free.
2. Please visit <https://techsammelan.in/> and create an account using the Sign-Up button.
3. Please fill out the details and submit them.
4. Please check your email for OTP. It may take 2-3 minutes.
5. Once you enter the OTP, your account is verified.
6. You have to log in using your email and password.
7. Click Conference Dashboard in the left menu.
8. Click Author and then click "Submit" under "1st PAN NIT National Conference on Management (1st PAN NIT NCM)"
9. Write your title, abstract keywords, and author details of your paper, upload the pdf file, and click "Submit."

PAPER ACCEPTANCE PROCEDURE:

- All submitted extended abstracts will undergo a rigorous double-blind peer-review process.
- Acceptance or rejection will be determined based on reviewer feedback.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

We invite authors to submit their abstracts for the 1st Pan NIT Management Conference in accordance with the following guidelines:

Extended Abstract Submission: Abstract submissions (not more than 2500 words)

Font: Times New Roman

Font Size: 12

Line Spacing: Double-spaced

Margins: Maintain a 1-inch (2.5 cm) margin on all sides.

References: Include a complete list of references at the end of the document, formatted according to the APA Style Guide (7th Edition).
