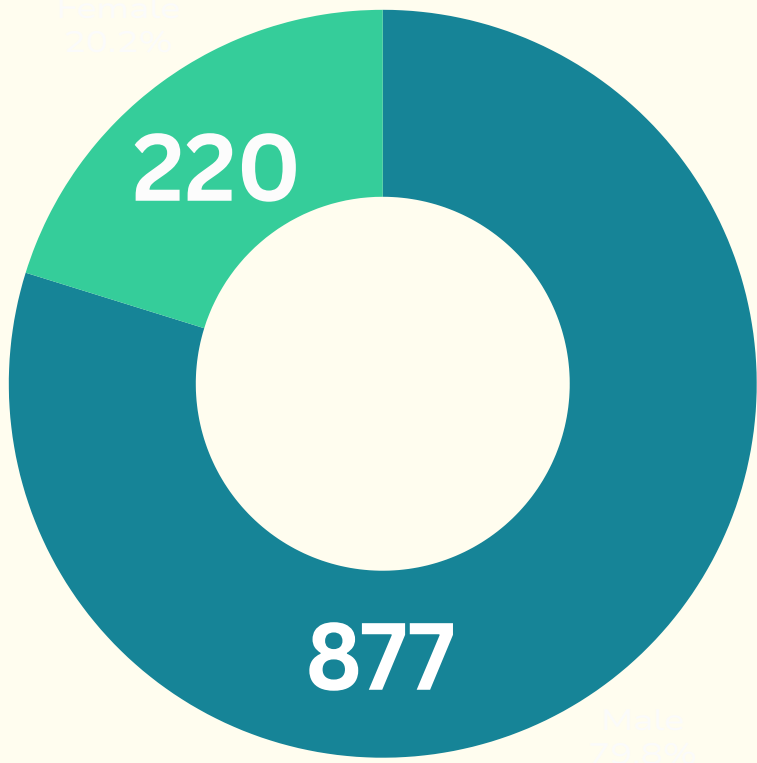


GENDER DIVERSITY DEMOGRAPHICS

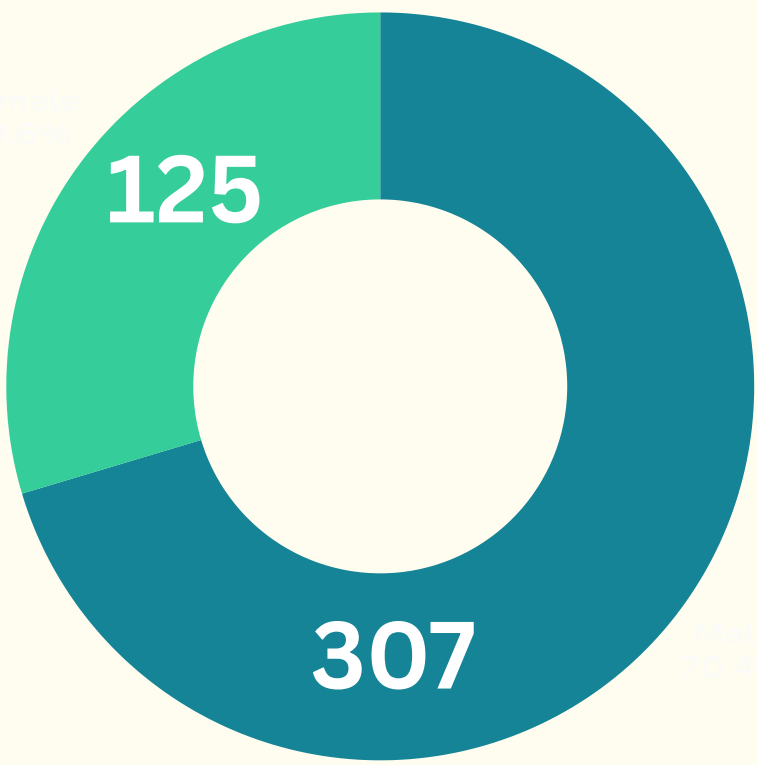

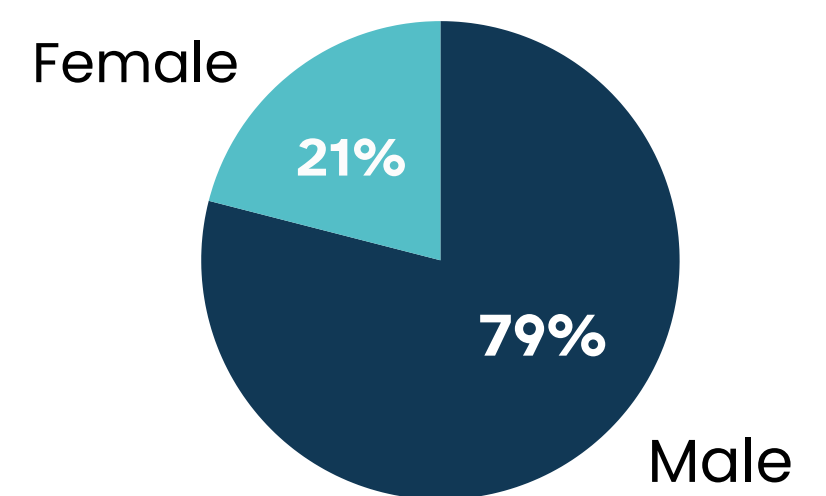

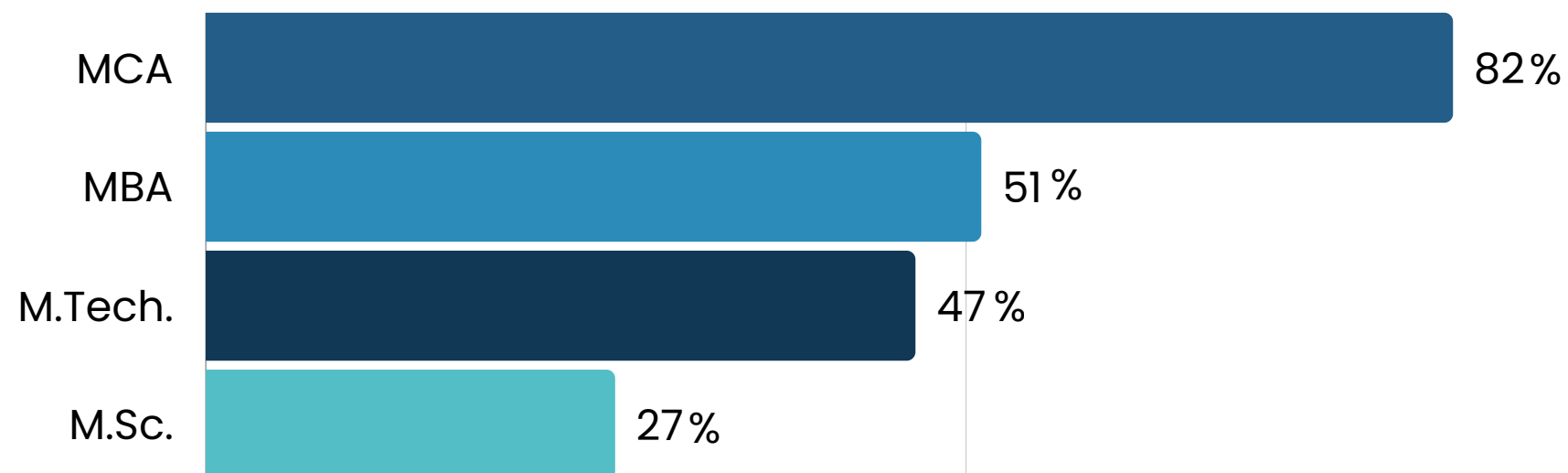

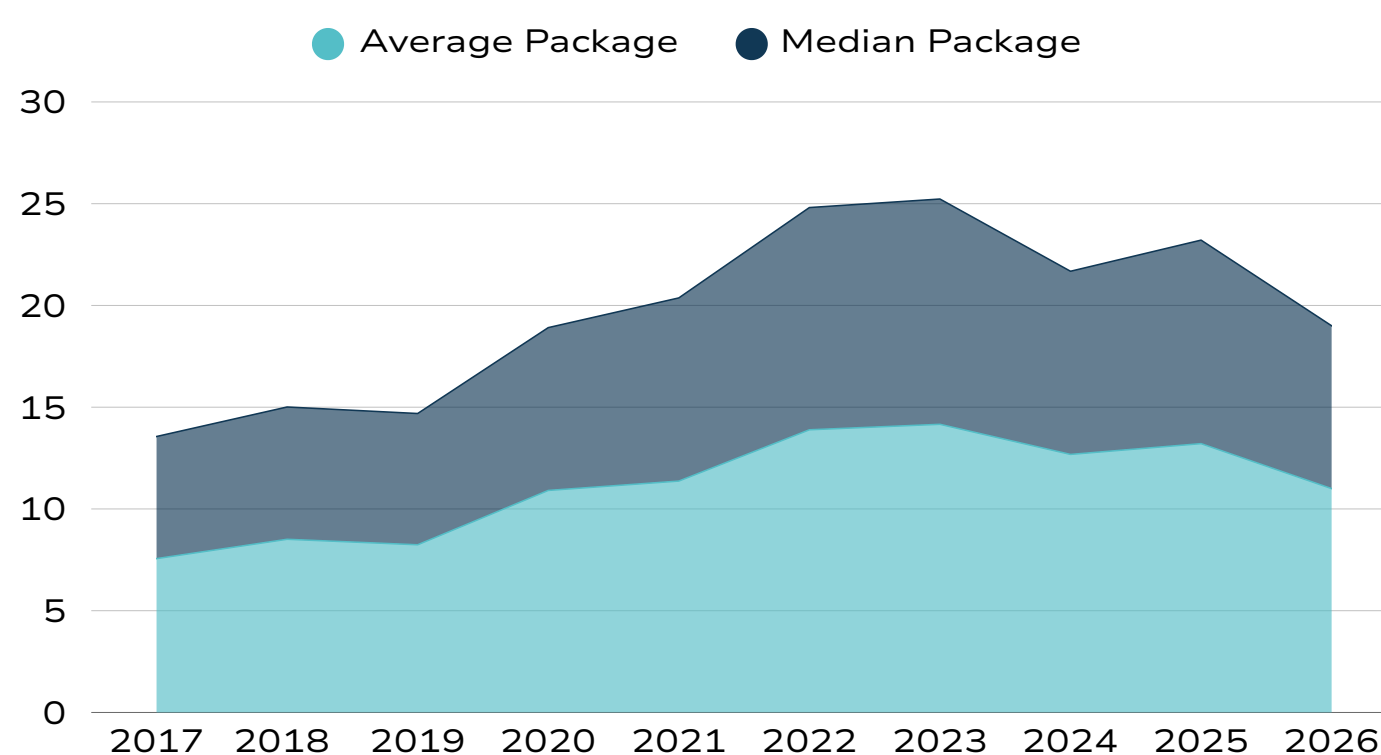
PLACEMENT STATISTICS (UG) 2026



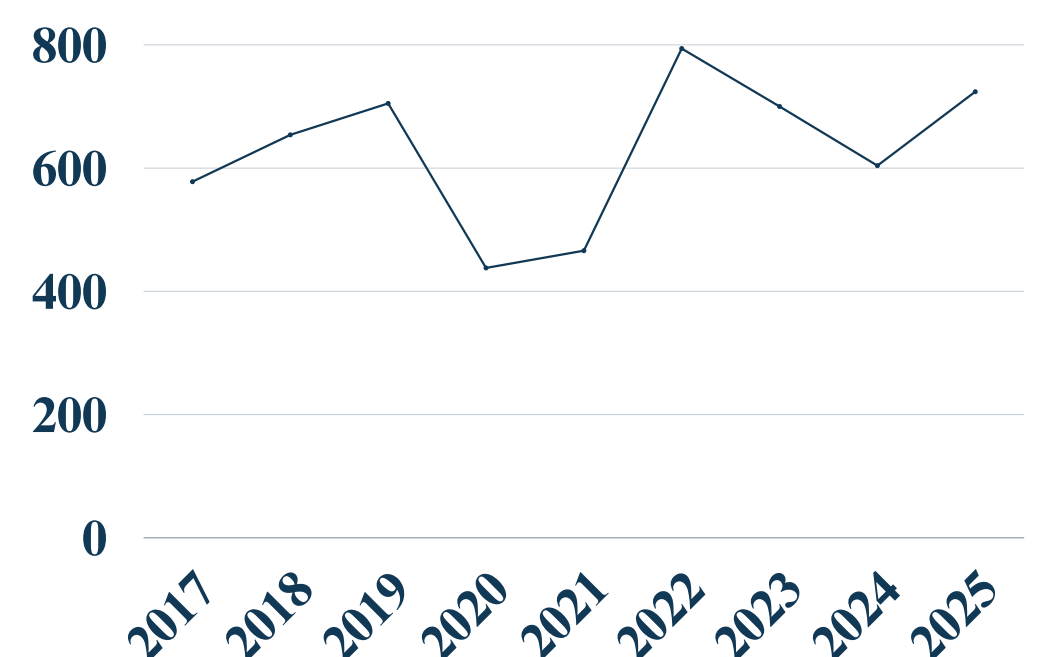

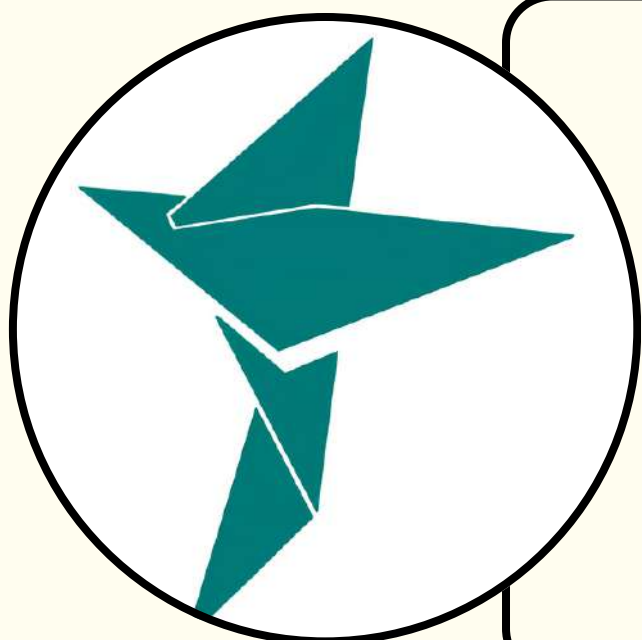




STUDENT LIFE

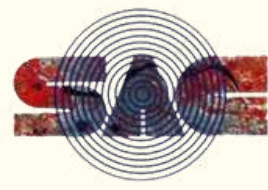

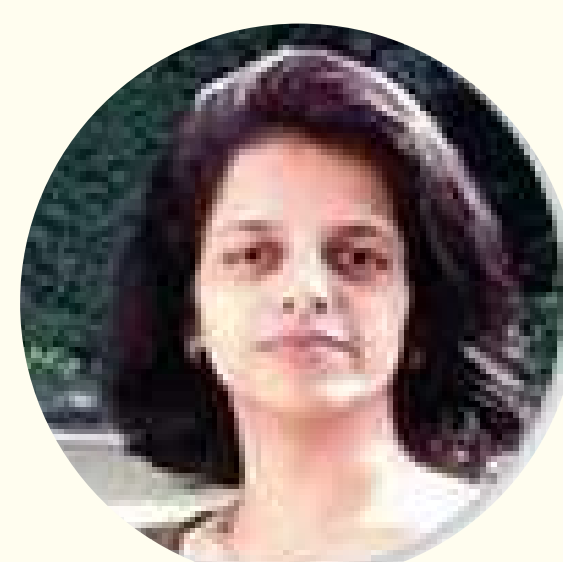

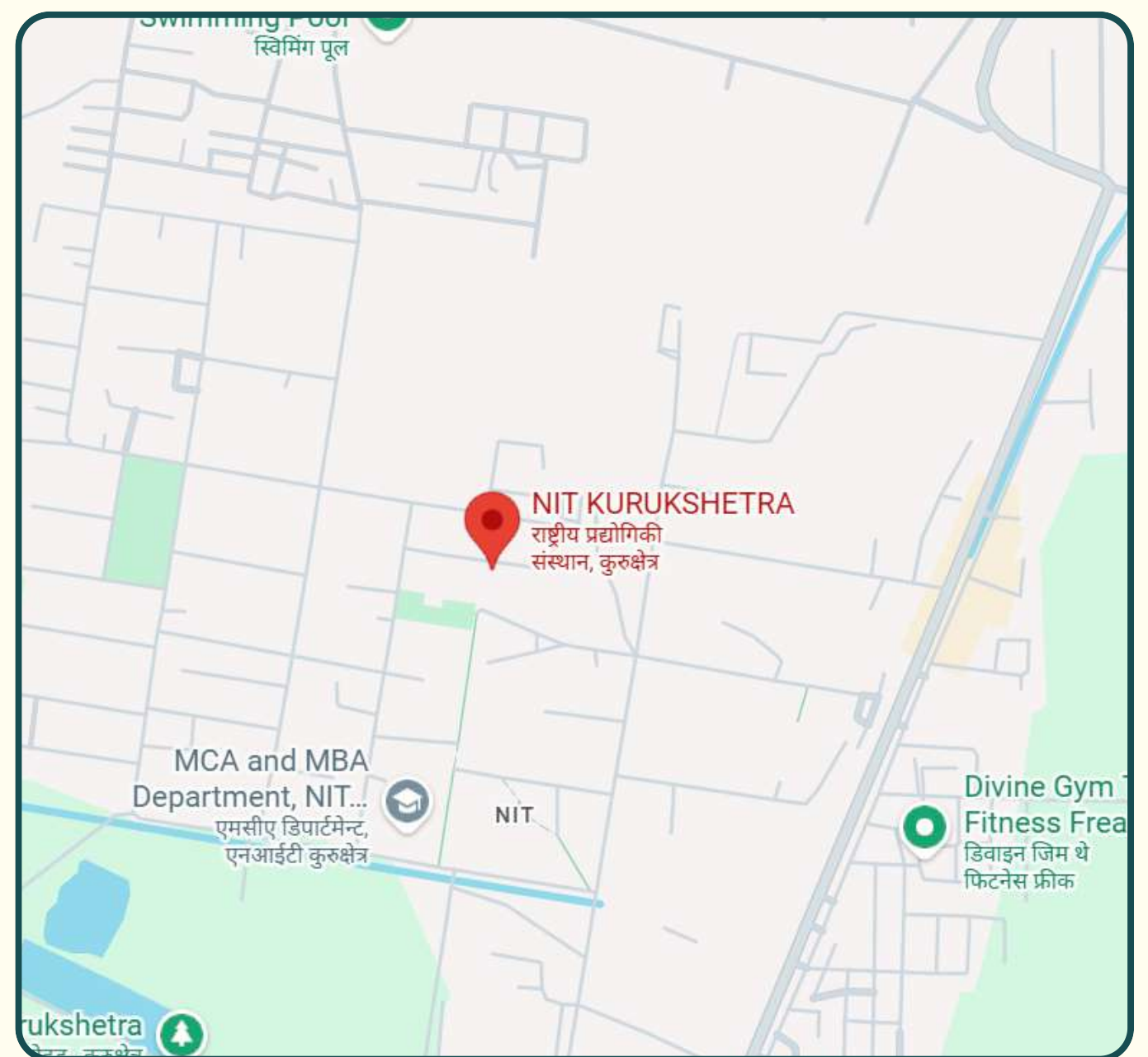
